I am more than happy to confirm your listening to Kang Guru Radio English. The program you heard was our reference number 20.05, with the program title 'Crezzy.'


Kang Guru is played on all 53 stations of Indonesia's government network, Radio Republik Indonesia, RRI. It is broadcast on more than 80 AM, FM and SW bands, and on any given day is broadcast up to 10 times, somewhere, in this vast archipelago. RRI estimate its audience at between 70 and 100 million people.

For your information, Jerry, yours is the third letter we have received this year from short wave radio enthusiasts. The previous two were from Japan. I understand that my predecessor received requests similar to yours from 18 countries, over the period of his six year tenure.
