

It's a very great pleasure to have a letter from you with so many items and details of reception report. Soon we checked it into the log of our recent program and we found out it's exactly correct.

Here we verify your report.

You've heard our station on December 6, and 9, 1973 on frequency 4765 KHz or 63 m from 11.23 to 12.00 and from 11.14 to 12.00 GMT.

Please find out your QSL card enclosed to this letter.

We're very glad to inform you, according to your desire to learn more about Medan ; You see Medan is the capital city of North - Sumatra province (it's one of 17 provinces in our Republic). Medan is 260 square km wide, with population of approx. one million people. As a capital city of north Sumatra there are 7 Universities and 5 academies. North Sumatra produces the famous tobacco leaves for cigar, while rubber, tea, palm oil are exported to various countries in the world of course it's incl U.S.A.

Our sea port is called Belawan 26 km from Medan and really busy harbour in this region. If you come by air you will land on Polonia International Airport, connecting our city with Singapore and Kuala Lumpur in Malaysia.

If you come on January to July it's the dry season, with a very little rain, but if you come between August and December it's really a rainy season, with almost rain fall every day of the week.

Speaking about mass communication in Medan there is one Government Radio Station (It's RRI) and there are 7 Private Radio - Stations (commercials and entertainment stations), there is one TV station (government) and there are 15 daily newspapers, 7 weekly and one monthly magazines.

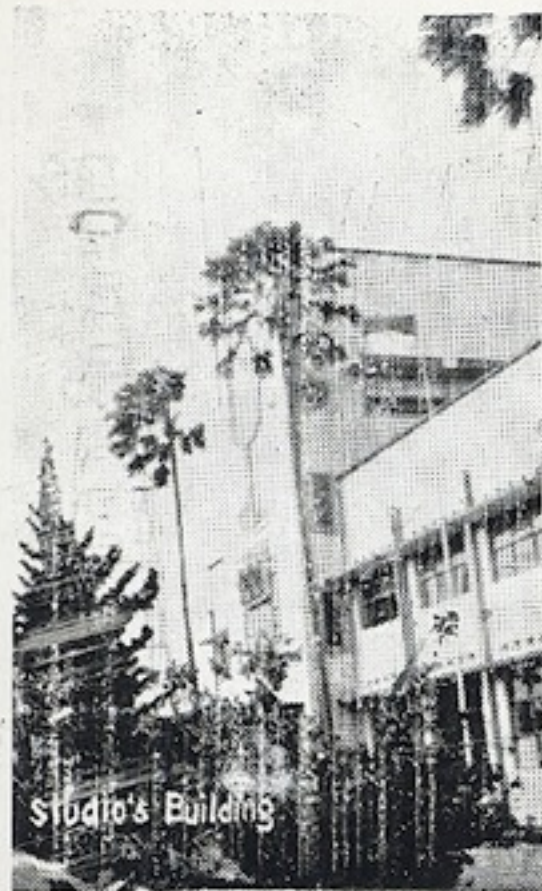

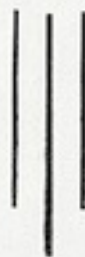
