Dear Sir:

This is to verify your report dated October 25 of my broadcast of October 25 in honor of the Radio Editor of "The Brooklyn Daily Eagle" and the DXers of the United States. Station CMCY was using 50 (fifty) watts and a frequency of 1345 kilocycles. Its wattage had been recently increased to 50 from 15.

Reports have been received of my two test broadcasts of October 18 and 25 from Indiana, Wisconsin, Ohio, Illinois, New York, Maine, N. H., Canada and other points. The "Brooklyn Daily Eagle" will probably publish in one of its Sunday editions, possibly that of Nov. 8, the names & addresses of all those whose reports verified their having picked me up. See the edition of Nov. 1 of that paper

for a write up on the broadcast.

Although it was my intention to continue my test programs on November 1, from 2 a. m. to 4 a. m., EST, as announced before signing off Oct. 25, I am sorry to report that I was unable to comply with my promise. On October 31 CMCY which had been broadcasting commercial programs daily, suspended its operations. These will be resumed exclusively as experimental work and demonstrations of the accessories and equipment (equipment especially pertaining to audio frequency) which I am preparing to install in conjunction with my sales and construction organization together with servicing department.

Within a few weeks I hope to be able to advise you the definite dates and hours of my test programs, which will be dedicated, possibly every Sunday a. m., to various Radio Clubs, newspapers and radio concerns and enthusiasts in the U. S. A. Until then, therefore, be patient and pardon the delay in verifying and the few hours of sleepless watchfulness I may have occasioned you and your friends last Sunday, November 1, morning.
