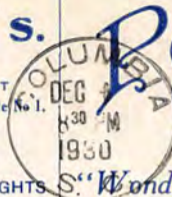

We appreciate your card and the compliments to the cadets. Hope we shall continue to interest you.

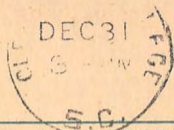

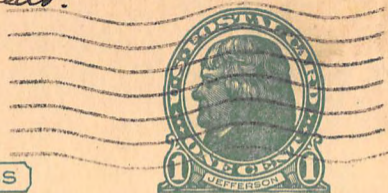
