S.I.M. entered Liberia in 1952 to establish ELWA and the first Gospel broadcast was aired January 18, 1954. God has prospered so that today broadcasts go out in the 13, 19, 25, and 60 meter bands, with regular programs in 36 languages. Recording studios are located in strategic areas where missionaries and nationals together produce Gospel programs that are sent to ELWA and broadcast back to their respective language areas. The Counselling Department and Bible Correspondence School, following up the broadcasts, have been mightily used of God.

ELWA, the first missionary broadcasting station on the continent is wholly dedicated to presenting Christ as the answer to Africa’s spiritual need.
