This letter confirms your reception of Voice of America's Colombo Relay Station located in Sri Lanka. According to our records, you heard our transmission to South Asia on February 24, 1991 on the following frequencies: 15250 KHz and 11705 KHz from 0050 to 0130 UTC.

Regrettably we apparently didn't receive your earlier request for verification. International mail from the United States and other countries often does not reach its intended recipient here in Sri Lanka for a variety of reasons.

I am pleased that you heard our broadcasts, even though they are only 30-kiloWatts. I appreciate your report, and am enclosing the latest VOA program schedule for South Asia, specifically serving Sri Lanka and India.
