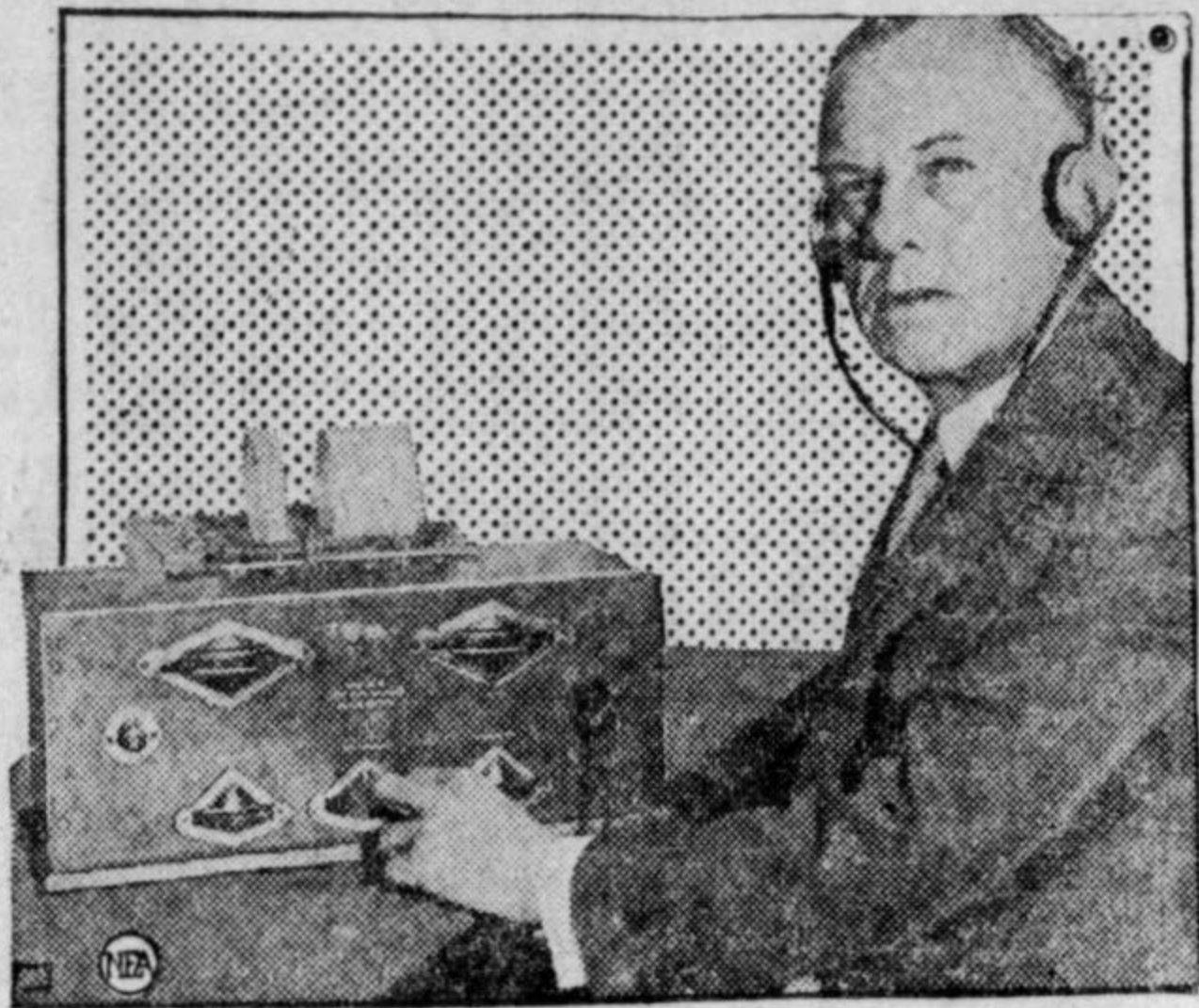




Ready for the Short Waves
