19.970	PUS	Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, with PPQ, at 2:55 P.M. sending program to WQG. (ERR)
19.850	WBE	Hicksville, N.Y., at 3 P.M., 1/18, on program channel test. (Roberts, Ind.)
15.355	KWU	Dixon, Calif., with KQY, heard calling Bandoeng at 2:35 P.M. (Roberts)
15.070	2RO--	Rome, Italy, NEW station logged at 8 A.M., 1/27, with lady in Italian. (ERR)
14.410	R--	U.S.S.R., heard at 8 A.M. in parallel with one on 10.06 mcs. (Roger Legge, N. (RHW, Moscow, listed on this frequency by Berne.)
12.390	????	Unidentified, man and woman alternating speaking language something like French at 6:40 P.M. Signal R4 but faded out at once. Could this possibly be the Russian RAX at Iakoutsk licensed on this frequency? (Roberts)
12.230	????	Station with poor modulation, R3, heard at 7:32 P.M., 1/24, with lady and man talking, too weak to identify the language. Heard only once. (Roberts)
12.120	TPZ	Algeirs, Algeria, with news in French at 4:30-4:50 P.M. R5. (Roberts)
11.830	VUD4	Delhi, India, gives news in English at 7:30-7:45 A.M., Signal fine. (ERR)
11.710	VLG3	Melbourne, Australia, heard at 4:15 P.M. on test transmission to N.Am. (RL)
11.540	????	Unidentified, logged at 9:48 A.M., 1/15, man chanting in Arabic style. Might be the old Polish transmitter SPD used by the Germans for Arabic programs. (R)
10.060	R--	Kuibyshev, USSR, heard at 7:30-9 A.M. with news in English at 7:50 A.M. (Roger Legge)
9.545	----	"Gustav Siegfried Eint", anti-Nazi, anti-Communist undercover station "somewhere in Germany", still heard afternoons and early evenings at 10 minutes before each hour, with talk in German. Is reported to be operated by German Army officers. (Roger Legge, Binghamton, N.Y.)
9.410	HJCJ	Bogota, Colo., relaying HJCK, heard several nights around 8 P.M. with excellent signal. Seems to be on irregularly though. (Roberts)
8.000	FIA6	"Radio Cameroun", Douala, Camerouns, operates at 6:45 A.M. and 1:15 P.M. according to the new issue of "France D'Abord". (Roger Legge)
7.285	JLG	Tokyo, broadcasts setting up exercises in Japanese at 5 P.M. (Roberts)
7.260	----	Weak station heard 5:30-6 P.M., music to 5:45, talking to signoff. CSW6? (ER)
7.257	JVW	Tokyo, news in English heard fairly well at 5 P.M., signs off at 5:30. (ER)
7.245	KGEI	San Francisco, on this new frequency heard at midnight, also 7 A.M. (Roberts)
7.200	EA---	NEW Spain station, heard well till signoff at 5:55 P.M. Is stronger than Valencia and other 41 meter Spanish stations. (Legge) Is R7 in Indpls. (ER)
7.075	???	Undercover European heard with talks in Serb at 2:15-2:30, 3-3:15, 3:30-3:45 P.M. Mentions no location or call letters. (Roger Legge)
7.063	---	"Radio Antigua", Antigua, B.W.I., heard 5-5:20 P.M. with news in French. (Legge) Received R4, 1/17, at 5:05 P.M. talking in French. An intentional interference covering 10 kcs. was set up shortly afterwards lasting to 5:30. Wonder if this came from Martinique? (ER)
7.037	EA--	Valencia, Spain, is R8 during last half hour to signoff at 6 P.M. (Roberts)
6.995	K---	NEW San Francisco, in parallel with KES, 10.41, and KEN, 6.845 at 2:30 A.M. January 18th, only. (Roberts)
6.174	HI9T	Puerto Plata, D.R., heard here early evenings in place of 6.555 mcs. (Legge)
6.160	CBRX	Vancouver, B.C., finally logged very weakly, 1/18, signing at 3 A.M. (Roberts)
6.155	????	European, received regularly 4:10-4:20 P.M. with anti-Vichy talks in French. Is heterodyned by CS2WD, Lisbon, Portugal. (Roger Legge)
6.105	XGAP	Peiping, China, NEW frequency logged with excellent R8 signals 1/25 with Oriental program at 7:30 A.M., English starting at 8 A.M. with announcement "This is XGAP, Peiping Central Broadcasting Station." (Roberts, Ind.)
6.090	XEBF	Jalapa, Mexico, R9, signing in Spanish and English at 2:54 A.M., 1/25. (ER)
6.060	HI6H	Ciudad Trujillo, D.R., on this new frequency signed off with HIN and HILN at 9:40 P.M., 1/25, but continued with some sport broadcast. (Roberts)
6.054	HJFA	Pereira, Colombia, logged during signoff at 10 P.M. Sundays. (Roberts)
5.790	????	Unidentified, logged at 8:15 A.M. speaking an Oriental language. Fading and local QRM was very bad. At 8:22 the man ceased his talk but the carrier of station was left on the air until after 8:40 when we tuned off. (Roberts)
2.915	GRC	London, received well evenings to 11:45 P.M. (Legge) Heard early as 6:15. (ER)
