- Mcs. Station, Location, Operating Hours (EWT), Etc.
- 18.160 ---- New NBC stations- WNRA, WNRI and WNRX are transmitting on the following frequencies: 18.160, 13.050, 9.355 and 7.565 mcs. Other frequencies may be in use but have not been heard as yet.
- 15.905 JAJA Location not given. Announcer however, had a pronounced English accent. He stated they were testing with JCJC, an Army station located in Cairo. This transpired at 7:45 A.M. October 17. Signal was excellent. (Might have been Cairo and then it might have been Greece).
- 15.750 ---- Radio Centro, Moscow, uses the following frequencies for morning transmissions beginning at 7:40 A.M.: 15.750, 12.270, 12.170, 11.885, 10.445, 9.565 and 8.140 mcs. For the 6:48 to 7:25 P.M. broadcasts: 15.110 and 15.230 mcs., and for the 8 P.M. program- 15.750 and 9.480 mcs.
- 15.460 KKR and KQG, 18.000 mcs., both in San Francisco, heard contacting WVLC and WVLS (somewhere in the Philippines) at 7:15 P.M. to relay General Douglas MacArthur's speech to the people of the Islands on October 20. On the succeeding day these two stations called NPN (at the same time) for a relay. Joseph A. Stauhs, Bloomfield (N.J.) NNRC member, volunteers that NPN is listed as being on Guam.
- 15.325 PIRM Slogan "The Voice of the Independent Party in the Philippines", signs on daily at 7 P.M. This station is decidedly pro-Jap. Signal ranges from fair to good. English announcements.
- 15.315 VLC4 Shepparton, Australia, and VLG3, 11.71 mcs. Melbourne, are using these frequencies for the daily 9:45 P.M. transmission to eastern North America, deleting VLG4, 11.840 mcs.
- 15.155 SBT Stockholm, Sweden, is used for the 8 A.M. relay to NBC. The New York contact is WQV, 14.800 mcs.
- 14.580 WMN Lawrenceville, N.J. is utilized for the Army Hour contacts with France every Sunday at 3:30 P.M. WMN was unable to pick up the French station direct. They stated at signoff that London supplied the contact.
- 12.000 ---- Lisbon, Portugal (no call given), signs on daily at 7 A.M. with a very good signal.
- 11.970 FZI Brazzaville, Free French Africa, currently has the best signal emanating from Africa. This station is on the air throughout the afternoon and evening at various intervals. It is also heard on 11.687 mcs. although your SW editor has never heard them mention that frequency. But they do mention 15.595 and 9.440 mcs. Has anyone heard them on 11.687 mcs?
- 11.950 ZPA5 Encarnacion, Paraguay, is broadcasting with a very much improved signal at present. This station is heard best at 7 P.M.
- 11.897 JVU3 Tokyo, heard at 12:15 P.M. October 21 with program to its partner-in-crime in Berlin. Regret we couldn't understand what was said. It is possible however, that the Japs were commiserating with the Nazis over the fall of Aachen or were trying to laugh off mirthlessly the return of General Douglas MacArthur and the Americans to the Philippines.
- 11.880 ---- Two stations on 11.880 and 11.765 mcs. believed to be in Algiers (they haven't mentioned call or location), relay the OWI, the Voices of America and the British Broadcasting Corp. all day long but seldom announce in English. However, news in English is heard at 6 A.M. and at 12:45 P.M.

11.700	HP5A	Panama City, Panama, relays CBS programs at 10 A.M. with English and Spanish announcements. This station verifies promptly.
11.645	----	Lebpolville, Belgian Congo, broadcasts in several languages during the early evening. Excellent signal. Shifts to 9.783 mcs. at 9:30 P.M. to relay BBC programs.
10.130	HHW3	Port-au-Prince, Haiti, broadcasts a program of popular dance music at 9 A.M. daily. Very good signal.
9.958	HCJB	Quito, Ecuador, has an English program daily at 7 P.M. Relays the news from San Francisco. Also broadcasts religious services. Excellent signal. Requests listeners to submit reception reports.
9.865	CR7BE	Lourenco Marques, Mozambique, relays the OWI, Voices of America and BBC programs. Heard as late as 5 P.M. Broadcasts with announcements in English but seldom gives its call in that language. It is easy to identify by its pleasant-sounding chimes.
9.840	VLV2	Sydney, Australia, is used for relays to NBC and CBS at 8 A.M. The San Francisco contact is KMI2, 9.870 mcs. Schedule was made for 3 P.M. with KWU, 15.355 and VLN4, 17.640 mcs.
9.670	----	British Mediterranean Station, is transmitting with a good signal daily at 1:45 P.M. when it presents the news in English. Employs the slogan "Voice of Palestine", operating in the 31 and 41 meter band. Has an interval signal that sounds like chords on a harp. Program continues at 2 P.M. in French. At 2:15 P.M. WNBI puts its carrier on the air and completely overrides this station.
9.660	LRX	Buenos Aires, Argentina is very good at 7 P.M. The listener to this station will hear plenty of tango and rhumba music. It announces every 15 minutes as "LR-uno, LR-ekkos, Radio El Mundo de Buenos Aires".
9.540	VE9AI	Edmonton, Alberta, Canada, presents programs of popular recordings throughout the afternoon on this frequency, switching to 6.005 mcs. for the evening and night. Signal is clear but not too strong. Relays CJCA.
9.480	JPHA	Hong Kong (under Jap control), has a much better signal than old ZBW3, the British call. The "benovolent" Japanese government announces over this station that it is going to improve the culture of the residents of Hong Kong by opening up a new library for their social welfare. Isn't that nice coming from the world's foremost barbarians and cutthroats. JPHA signs on at 7 A.M. daily with a program announced in English. A program especially for Asiatics follows at 8 A.M.
9.465	CR6RA	Luanda, Angola, is again being heard at 3:30 P.M. It features popular dance tunes and signs off at 4:30 P.M. with rendition of the Portuguese national anthem.
9.100	ICD	Located somewhere in Italy, is again using this frequency for evening relays to NBC and CBS at 6:30 P.M. ICD is still on 14.480 mcs. for its 8 A.M. broadcasts. Your SW editor heard this station at 6:45 P.M. October 21 on 10.615 mcs. when it was stated there was too much interference on 9.100 mcs. The New York contact is WQW, 10.600 mcs.
8.600	----	Radio Italia Liberta, an Axis-controlled station, broadcasts with a very good signal from 5 to 6:30 P.M. when it signs off. This outfit broadcasts Italian and Spanish programs.
