Thank you very much for your letter of August 21st with details of reception for the same date. Our wavelength is 33.3 metres, or 9,009 kcs.

As our transmitter is only $7\frac{1}{2}$ kwts, until we are in a position to start using a much stronger one, it is quite a pleasant surprise to hear of 80% readable reception so far away.

The program you heard was indeed called "Mirror of Israel". We ran this series for some time but it is now off the air.

We have no independent station but use the facilities of the Government station, Kol Yisrael, the Voice of Israel, so I am enclosing one of their QSL cards for your collection. I note you already have 52: I hope this does not make us the "joker"!
