

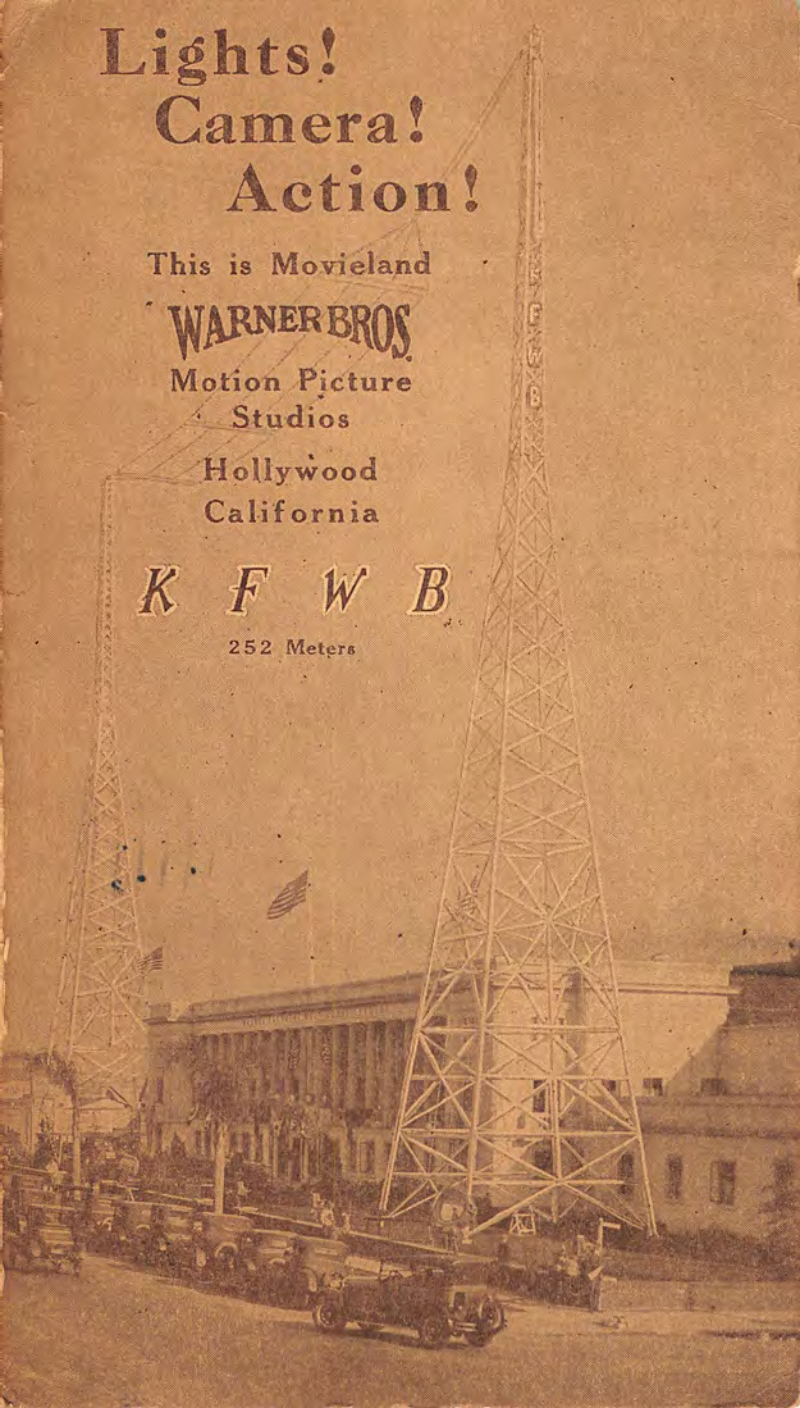

Your card posted March 12th seeking verification of reception of KLX from 2:45 to 3 a.m. E.S.T. has been received, checked with the station log by the program director and this will serve as official verification of reception. The recordings you list were played and the signoff checks with our log.

Yesterday we increased power from 500 watts to 1000 watts. May I ask that you check, at your convenience, another KLX program and let us know whether it was received with better volume than before, any clearer, what as to fading and interference from other stations.

For your information KLX operates until 11 p.m. Pacific Time every night except Saturdays, when we operate to 12 midnight.
