DER DEUTSCHE SOLDATENSENDER ("The German Soldiers' Station"): Claiming to operate from West Germany, but actually transmitting from Burg/Magdeburg, East Germany, and with studios in East Berlin, Soldatensender broadcasts lively programming daily in German primarily for West German soldiers. It is operated by the East German Ministry for National Defense and formerly shared facilities with the now-inactive Deutscher Freiheitssender 904.

RADIO ESPAÑA INDEPENDIENTE ("Radio Independent Spain"): Station of the Spanish CP, broadcasting in Spanish and Catalan to Spain from various locations since 1941, making it the oldest station of its type now on the air. Currently, it broadcasts from Rumania, sharing facilities with Radio Portugal Livre, and is also relayed once daily via Radio Budapest, Hungary. In addition, it maintains an editorial office in Paris, from where QSL cards are sent. Jammed.

RADIO EUZKADI ("Radio of the Basque Nation"): Station of the Euzkadi-Gaztedi (EGI), the Basque nationalist government-in-exile, with headquarters in Paris and transmitters of nominally 80 kw each supposedly located near St. Jean de Luz, France, but actually located near Caracas, Venezuela. Broadcasts in Spanish, Basque and English to Spain and the world. Distinctive clipped audio sound. Shifts frequency to avoid jammers.

RADIO FREE EUROPE/RADIO LIBERTY: CIA-financed (US\$30 million annually) stations in Eastern European languages (RFE) and Soviet languages (RL) to Eastern Europe and the USSR on many frequencies most of the day. Usually heavily jammed, but often intelligible anyway. RL shortwave transmitters of up to one megawatt are in Spain, Germany and Taiwan; RFE medium and short wave transmitters of up to 250 kw are in Portugal and Germany. For details, see WRTH under "Germany". V. free; ask site to be specified. N.B.: Pending legislation now before the U.S. Congress, if passed, will eliminate the CIA link with these stations. RADIO FREE RUSSIA: Station of the strongly anti-communist Narodno-Trudovoy Soyuz (Popular Labor Union), a seemingly-independent underground espionage group, transmitting in Soviet languages to the USSR from mobile transmitters in West Germany, plus relays over BCC, Taiwan, and VoFK, Seoul. Jammed.

RADIO PORTUGAL LIVRE ("Radio Free Portugal"): Station of the Portuguese CP, formerly broadcasting from Algeria, but currently transmitting from Rumania to Portugal in Portuguese via facilities shared with Radio España Independiente. Audio sometimes distorted. Subject to peculiar interferences, which may be deliberate.

SOUTH VIETNAM LIBERATION RADIO (Giải-Phóng): Station of the South Viet Nam Provisional Revolutionary Government (PRG), formerly the South Viet Nam National Front for Liberation. Chinese-built transmitters, nominally located "inside the South Vietnamese jungle", but actually located in Cambodia, transmit to Indochina, South East Asia and Europe in Vietnamese, Laotian, Khmer, Chinese, French and English. This station should not be confused with the program carried over the Voice of Vietnam transmitter on 10176 at 1200, called "Đài la boi phát thanh Phóng Miền" ("This is Radio Free South").
