

SECTION IV - NNRC SPECIAL SURVEY - LATIN AMERICAN STATIONS

Here is a SPECIAL Survey of Latin Americans, which we hope you will find helpful in tracking down some of these stations to the south. This list contains only stations reported as being heard recently. There is much confusion generally among SWL concerning these stations due to the inaccuracy of most information available. Thus, we hope this listing will do a little to help NNRCers in their listening to LA stations. This list does not claim to have all stations on the air listed, so if you hear any others let us know about them & we will publish the info in future Surveys.

This Special Survey lists the times that stations can usually be heard in the U. S. in Eastern Standard Time. Remember that signals on these lower frequencies need a night-time path, and that now that the nights are becoming shorter they will start fading out earlier in the mornings and coming in later in the evenings. Stations heard from Latin America 3 to 8 megacycles are covered in this Special Survey.

Reports were received this month from Roger Legge, Albert K. Saylor, William Schultz, and Stuart Fidler, on the East Coast; and Gordon Nelson, Don Kenney, and William Flynn on the West Coast. These were the first reports to the Survey from the West and they do hear stations out there that we in the east don't. Keep those reports coming and the Band Survey should be better than ever.

Also comments, all in favor of continuing the Survey, were received from Gerry Dexter, Michael Dorgan, A. It was good to hear from you all, and it looks like the Band Survey is here to stay.

Next month - the 17, 21, and 25 megacycle bands, including stations 17 to 27 MC. These bands were covered in last August's Band Survey, which should be helpful for those who want to check these bands and sending in reports. Also don't forget that we can use information on changes of any station. This is listed at the end of each Survey so that the previous Surveys will be correct.

The deadline for reports will be the 10th of each month from now on. This will be the date that the compiling of the information received will be started. Reports received after this date will be used as long as the Survey has not yet been completed and sent off. The April Band Survey will cover the stations 14 to 17 mcs.
