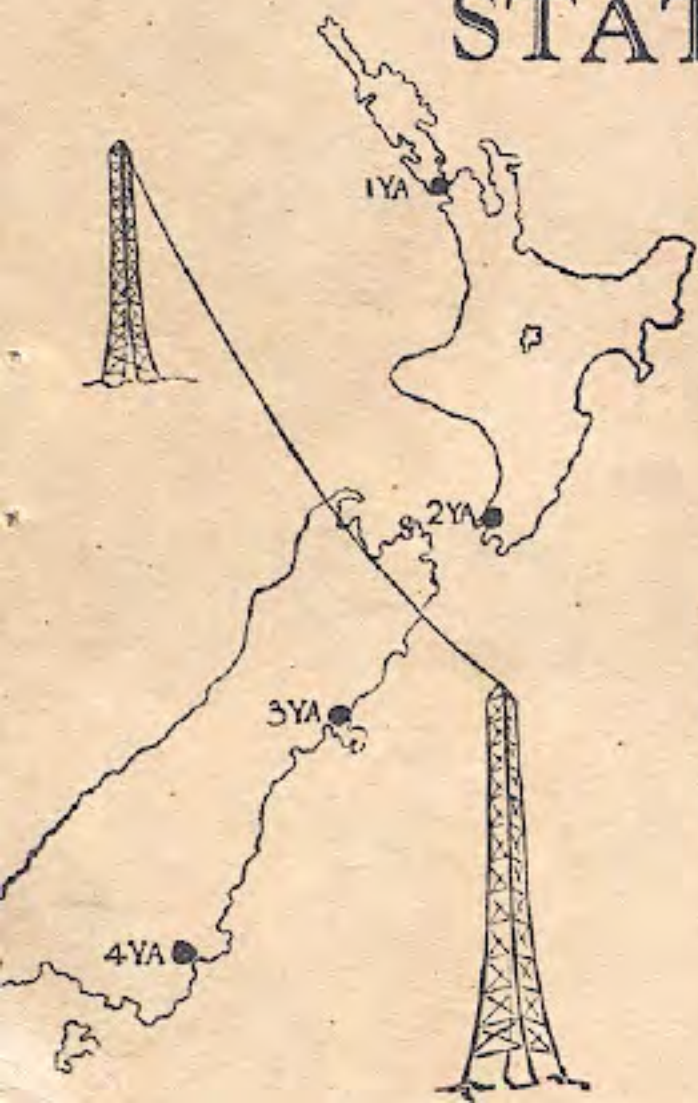

Thank you for your letter advising reception of this station on 30th November, 1959. Please find enclosed our official verification card. We received another report from Waterloo, Iowa, of reception of 1YZ at this time.

1YZ is a unit of the New Zealand Broadcasting Service, a State owned broadcasting system which operates all stations in New Zealand, both commercial and non-commercial. Our radiated power is 10 kilowatts, from a transmitter situated near Te Puke in the Bay of Plenty in the North Island of New Zealand. Our studios are some 30 miles inland at Rotorua.

We understand there is a station in Windsor, Canada on our frequency which is only off the air during the early hours of Monday morning each week. This would explain your picking us up at that time.

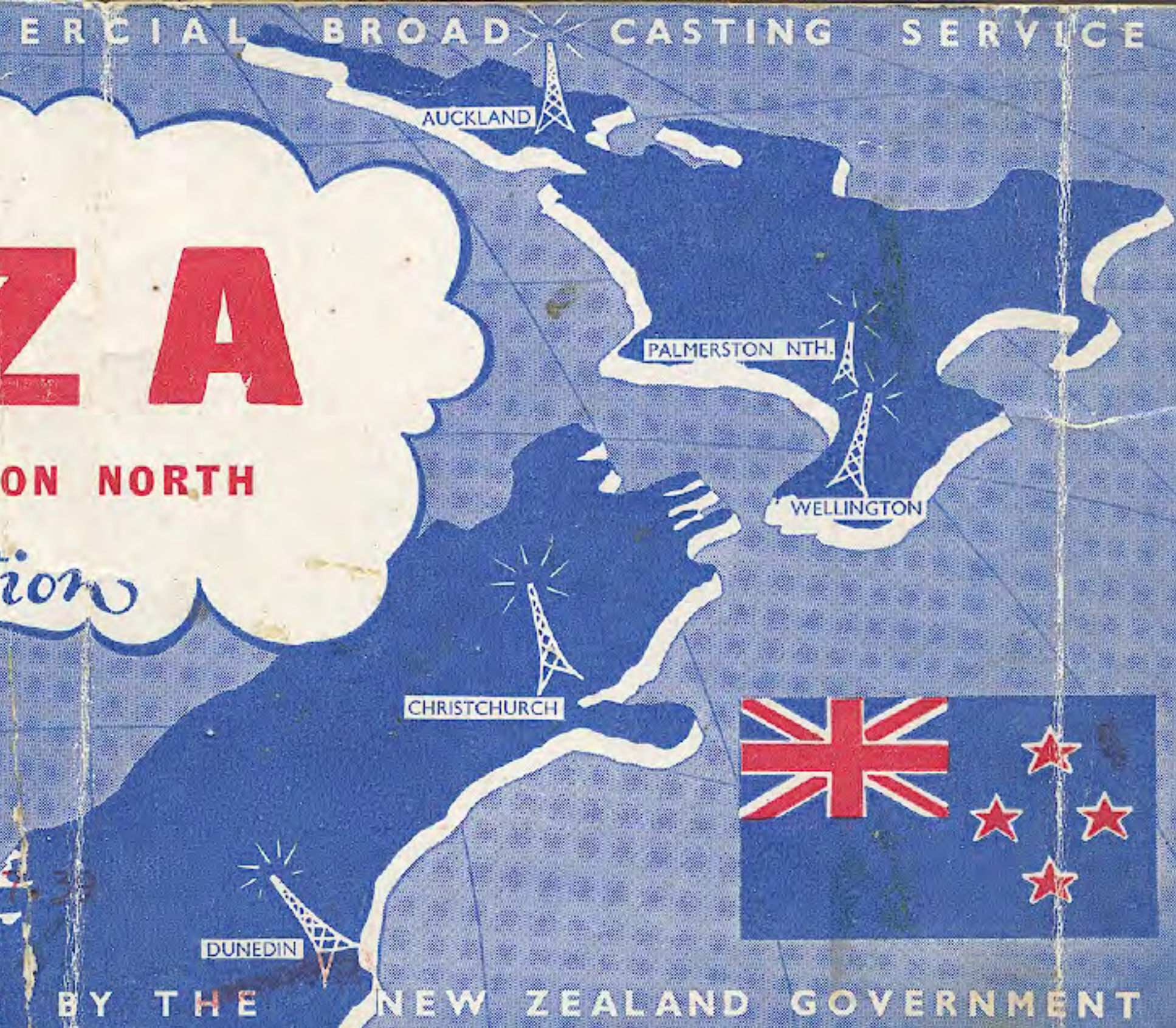

I have to thank you for your report on reception from 2ZE, Eketahuna, such records as you specify having been played. Unfortunately I have never troubled to have a station card printed.

It is hard to understand the distortion you mention as modulation seemed crystal clear locally, but of course it would either be in the station or in the atmosphere, where the engineers at 2YA, etc., say it is!

On Sunday I had just installed a new bank of 50-watt Philips valves in the transmitter and was adjusting up.

My power is about 35 watts, but the transmitting aerial is hung underneath the iron roof of The Eketahuna "Express".

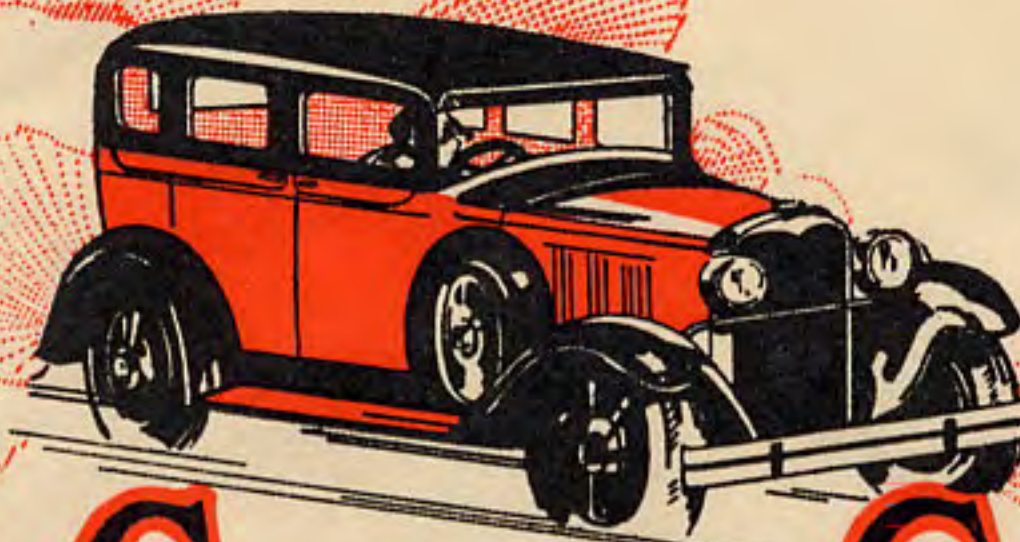

We thank you for your letter reporting reception of our broadcasting station, 2ZQ.


At the time you received us our transmissions were only of the experimental nature and the power was approximately 10 watts. However, we have now constructed our proper transmitter and ~~are~~ are testing out for our opening night. Our power output will then be approximately 50 watts.

We are using only a temporary aerial at present but have in course of construction a lattice mast which will bring the aerial 120 feet above street level. This should result in a great improvement in strength in your district.

We should be glad to have any further reports from you when our station is properly operating.


