A. y el apoyo de la Honorable Municipalidad de la Ciudad de Heredia; CONMEMORA TAMBIEN el hecho único en el mundo, como lo es la Franquicia Postal Oficial concedida por el Supremo Gobierno de la República, y los maravillosos records obtenidos por la diminuta estación NRH en ondas cortas de 30,8 metros y usando tubos con 7 1/2 watts y 500 volts en la placa, logrando con tan pequeñísima potencia ser oída noche a noche en los países indicados al pie de este Diploma, y aún cruzar el Atlántico hasta Europa, cual otro Lindy del Centro de América!

AND COMMEMORATES THE ACQUISITION of the 150 watts «Master Oscillator Power Amplifier» with 2000 volts Rac,—and of the Mike with its remote control,—both outfits donated to NRH by ardent listeners on the American Continent, together with several USA radio factories and the Most Honorable Municipality of the City of Heredia; IT ALSO COMMEMORATES the unique fact, as it is, the free use of Service Postal Mail authorized by the Supreme Government of the Republic, as a Prize to the efforts and perseverance of our broadcasting using 30,8 meters of waves with 7 1/2 watts power only, with which, night after night, did established famous records of Dx which covered the countries listed belcw on this Diploma, titling our Short Wave Station as the Lindy of Central America!

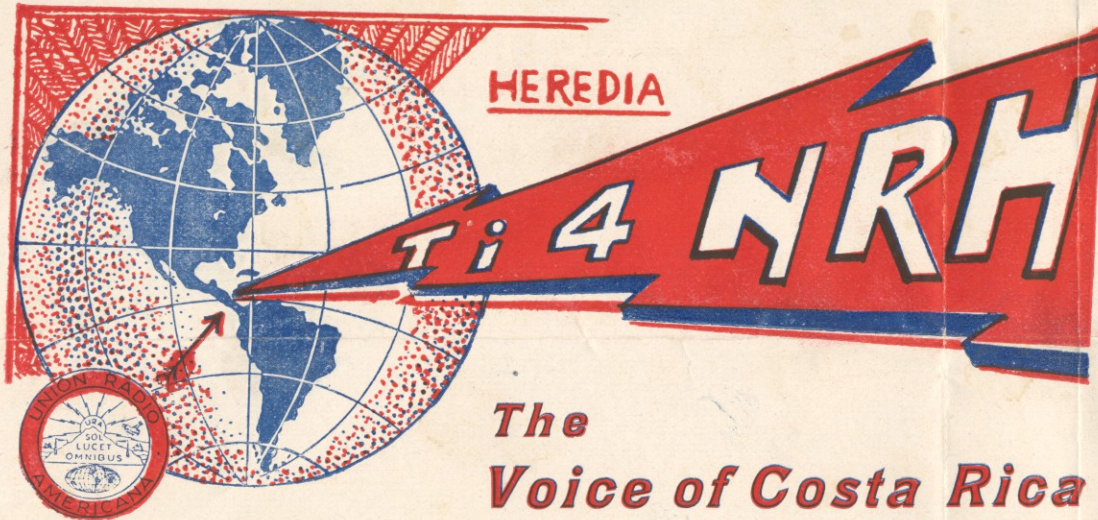

 towards happiness, we have friends all over the World.

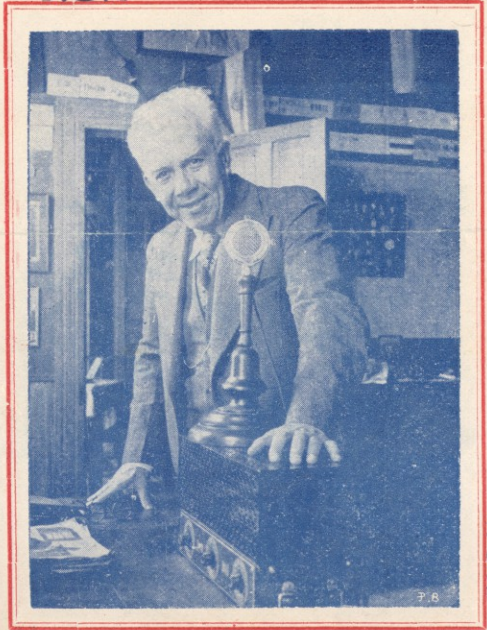
