- 6.140 4VB Radio Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti; hrd somedays at 1800. Other days at 6.085. (ARN) Hrd on 6.091 at 1800 with recorded music in French. (RP)
- 6090 4VB Radio Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti hrd 2000 with classical music. (SCW)
- 6091 4VB Radio Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti hrd 2015 with American pop music and French ann'ments. Identified several times with something like "Ici Alukamayas" and later with "Ici Radio Commerce" and "Radio Commerce a presente". Power is 7500 watts. (PT)
- 9485 Radio Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti has an ENGLISH feature on Sunday at 1700; native music and talks about the country of Haiti are high lights. (RTVN, JP)
- 9485 4VC Radio Commerce, Haiti noted 0630 s/on with "Stars and Stripes Forever" and with Sunday feature of "Glimpse of Haiti" at 1705-1730. (JP); noted 0630 with French program of news. (DS)

- 6122 4VB Radio Commerce, Haiti noted here regularly since moving here and Luxembourg now good on 6090. (JP) 4VB noted 6115 in search of a hole in the 49 meter band. (GF)
- 9485 4VC Radio Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti noted with music 0655 (MC); French and music at 0840 (PF); French news and music at 1700 and 0630 (DS); ENGLISH pgm "Glimpses of Haiti" at 1715 Sundays (GD); nice signal at 1730 (JP); no time signals or news hrd at 1900 as mentioned in World Radio Handbook (RDY); In addition to the SUN: only pgm "Glimpses of Haiti", Radio Commerce now has ENGLISH on Thursday 2300-2315 on 4VB, 6091. (RTVN)

- 6122 4VB R. Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti has moved up from 6090 at times because of QRM from R. Belgrano, Argentina. Uses this channel Mon-Sat at 1700-2230. 9485 is only outlet used on Sundays. On May 15th 4VB found back on 6090 at 2100. (SW)
- 6105 4VE, Radio Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti is now regularly hrd at good strength with English at 0500-0615 and 2000-2040. (4, BF)
- 9485 4VC Radio Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti noted 1800-1830 in French and LA music. Music to 1830. At 1830 an ENGLISH announced pgm "Paris Star Time" (which is NOT from Paris as some reporters originally thought-Ed.). This pgm is French music and lyrics and ENGLISH ann'ments from 1830-1900. French ID at 1900 and closedown. (BV)

- 5985 R. Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti, noted with Eng. at 2100 (26); Hrd on 5950 from 0900-0915 on Tue.,Thu.,Fri.; 0500-0530 on Sun. These pgms in Eng. (263)
- 1959
- 5982 R. Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti (4VB) now using this channel for all b/c; have dropped 9543 kc; "Glimpses of Haiti" Sun at 1700-1730; in German to 1830; then "Paris Star Time" in Eng. to 1900. Sunday s/off 1900. (4) (Also 44, 100)
- 5985 4VB, R. Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti; 2045-2058 light music; ads to 2100; "La Voix de la Republique d'Haiti" ID to 2200; "Ice R. Commerce" after 2200. Informative show with French talks to 2200. (1EM, VE2PELU)
- 1963
- 9545 4VC, R. Commerce, Port-au-Prince, Haiti; 1900 LA mx, Fr. anmts, & IDs; also in Sp. from 2130 with thanks to all who gave help (presumably during the recent hurricane-Editor), then in Fr. to 2158 with news & singing. (2KHS, 4BC)

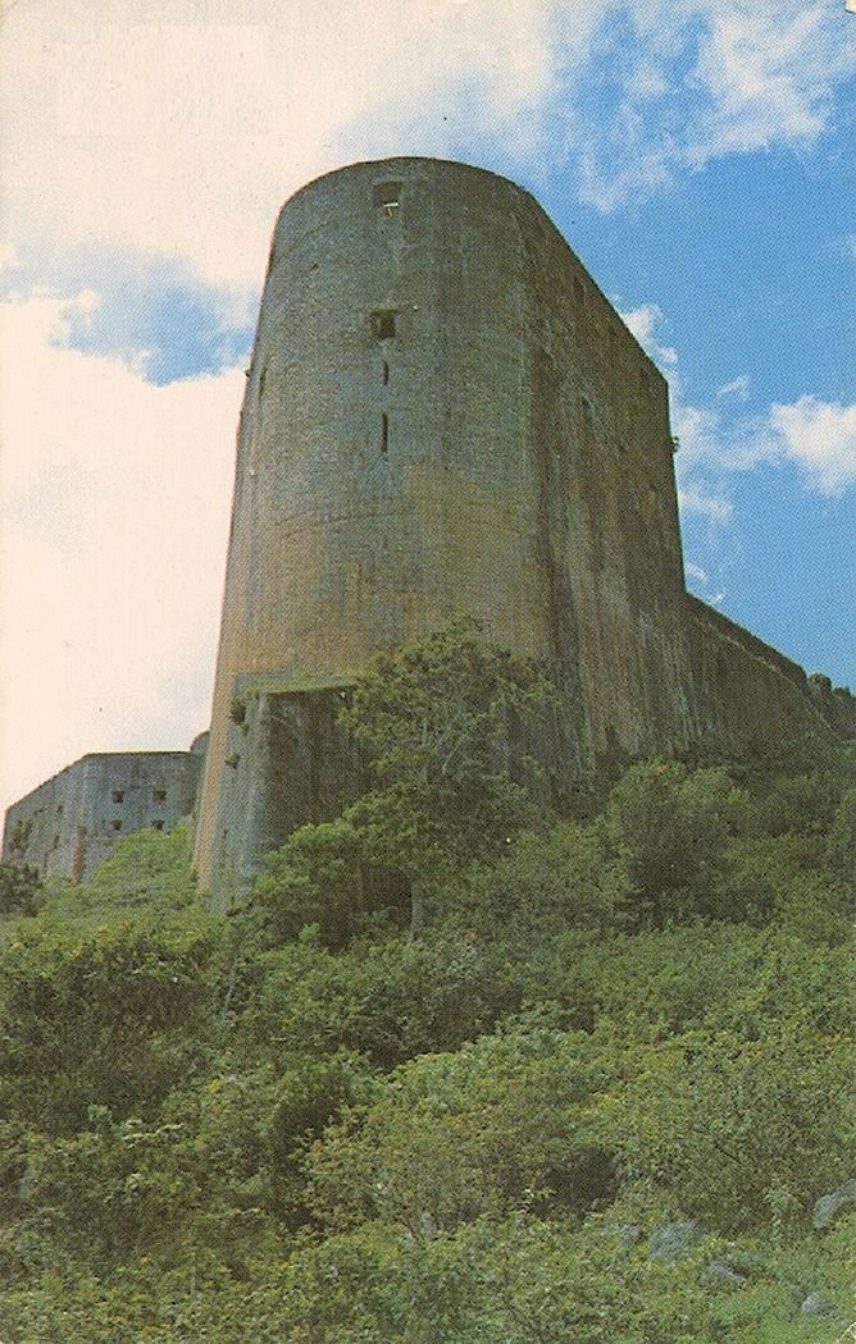

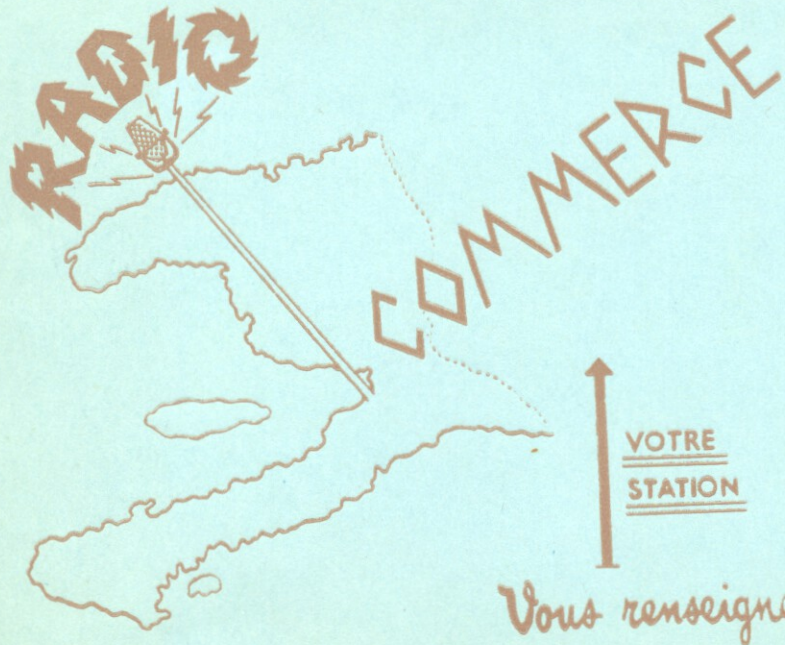

Poste 4VA, émettant sur 1080 kilocycles, puissance à l'antenne 1000 watts.—
Ondes longues.

Poste 4VB, émettant sur 6091 kilocycles, puissance à l'antenne 7500 watts.—
Ondes courtes : 49 mètres.

Poste 4VC, émettant sur 9485 kilocycles, puissance à l'antenne 7500 watts.—
Ondes courtes : 31 mètres.

L'ANTENNE DE L'EMETTEUR 4VA est du type vertical de 220 pieds de haut, reposant sur des isolateurs et maintenue en équilibre par cinq rangées de câbles isolés. L'antenne est reliée à l'émetteur par une ligne de transmission coaxiale de 230 ohms.

Le système de terre est composé de 120 rayons de 250 pieds de long espacés de 3 degrés.

Ce poste sera entendu avec une puissance suffisante pour couvrir les interférences atmosphériques sur un rayon de 200 miles.

LES ANTENNES POUR ONDES COURTES, installées dans la direction Est-Ouest, sont du type "Delta" horizontal, et sont supportées par des pylones d'acier de 80 pieds pour les 31 mètres et 60 pieds pour les 49 mètres.

Tous les émetteurs, contrôles, consoles de commande et accessoires ont été fabriqués par la "Radio Corporation of America".
