This month we are adding two new names to the list of those receiving this sheet - Ralph Hunnewell of New Hampshire and H.L. "Chad" Chadbourne of California. For the newcomers and in review, this is free service to those consistently make SWR a success. No contributions are wanted. SWR is a valuable reference for my ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ professional writing and, frankly, there doesn't seem to be anything else around just like it.

A disaster occurred with the April SWR. After cutting 4 stencils, my typewriter stopped dead and the last page had to be omitted. Most items between S and Z did not get into print and the most important of these are included here.

ADEN Apparently the station hrd in California at 1500 on 5050 kc is NOT R. Aden at least they advised WSP they could not verify his report. Meanwhile HLC believes he heard this station at 1500 III/17 on 7165 and a tentative report has been sent (Chad, I will feature your article on THRESHOLD HEARING in the May SWR)

IRAN SAR please let WSP (901 Hearst Building, San Francisco 3) know the latest frequency on which you hear R. Tehran in the 41M. I think you said 7098 but can't remember for sure.

NEPAL Possibly this country on 7105 with S/Off between 1515 and 1520, before that American style dance music and popular English vocals (WSP)

SENEGAL R. Senegal 11895 Dakar now has Eng news at 1905, still by YL but either she had a cold when I heard it they or they or they have changed announcers. This one is in the clear after 1900 when RFE signs off.

NOTE TO ARO: This one has a new folder type QSL, specifies freq. so in my opinion is an improvement (mine is for BCB reception).

SOUTH AFRICA R.S. Africa has a new XMSN on 9650 with S/On at 0615 followed by market report, English and Afrikaans alternate days (ABA) SAR: your bird call at 0429 on 60 meters is the conclusion of a similar program and is not RSA's regular IS. Fooled me at first too. Incidentally RSA should start using 120M antime now - 2326 and 2346 S/on at 0400, 2376 Springbok Radio at 0300 and all night Sat AM.

SYRIA R. Damascus 15160-5AV now has it's Eng at 1700-1730, first noted by HLC and later after the revolution on III/17 at which time they seemed to be jammed (ARO)

TAIWAN B.C.C. has a new Eng XMSN at 1445-1515 on 9685. For the 0250 Eng to NA, 11825 is now used instead of 11860 (ABA)

UGANDA R. Uganda at Kampala seems to have replaced 5026 with 4975. Noted II/26 at 2045-2103 S/Off preceded by news (ARO)E

USA WINB has moved it's 16M XMTR (carrier hum and all) to 17720 from 11735 as of III/3. (SAR & RHU: I will run your long items on this station in the May SWR. KGEI has gone back to 9590, Noted III/17 at 0245-0300 w/Spanish (ARO)

Has anyone hrd R. Sweden to NA on listed 7270??? Can't find them anywhere here, 6065 is blocked by VOA Greenville. WSP hears them at 1445-1515 to SE Asia on new 9660 and I can usually hear their African XMSN at 1745 on (last time I checked) 11705. Finally something of a phantom has been reported by Juanita Andrews of Chicago and a NYC EI reader - apparently clandestine, using a variety of freq between 5600 KI & 6150, XMSNs of about 7 min in Spanish consisting of code names and/or numbers (ex Amadio 196) almost anytime after 0500 GMT. I haven't heard it yet but doesn't seem to be a hoax so be on the lookout.

Plenty of territory to cover this time so let's get right to it;

- CRANDESTINE** Your editor has finally hrd the Spanish speaking phantom, on VI/15, and it is not one but two stations. #1 was logged at 2005 concluding a XMSN on 6470 then #2 apparently replied on 6330A at 2012. #2 is much stronger and was also hrd VI/14 at 2020 on 6300A. These XMSNs begin with a name and 2 digit number. This is repeated for about 4 minutes and is followed by a series of 5 digit numbers.
- CAMBODIA** Phom Phen is using new 17705 at 0130-0230 w/Eng news at 0200 (ABA/6)
- CUBA** AS you know SHM/6 claims he is hearing COCO regularly on 9530 and Circuito CMQ (hrd regularly on the BCB) also announces this call. However even after the VOA S/Off at 0430, I can find no trace of this station. Now it could leave the air at 0430 and/or it could be directional E/W. WOULD YOU FELLOWS IN CALIFORNIA PLEASE DOUBLE CHECK THIS CHANNEL. Meanwhile R.Prógresso hrd on MW via CMBC 690 kc is again announcing COBC but I can find no trace on the old frequency of 9360.
- MOZAMBIQUE** R.Clube de Mocambique is using new 17755 but Sundays ONLY at 0700-0900 & all Portugese (ABA/6)
- PAPUA** New VLF3 3335 Port Moresby hrd w/Eng at 1115, sked is 0900-1330 (ABA/6)
- PHILIPPINES** "The Voice of the Catholic Philippines" hrd via DXH5 on new 9690 at 0930 w/Eng & Tagalog (ABA/6)
- PORTUGAL** According to The Voice of the West, although Emisora Nacional XMTRs are used, they are two separate organizations.
- SENEGAL** R.Sengal noted on new 15380 at 1930-2100 in French and unknown languages (ABA/6)K
- USA** According to an article in "BROADCASTING" which has been reproduced and distributed by Carl McIntire, all applications for international broadcast stations ^{have been frozen} pending a review the rules governing such stations. Also according to BROADCASTING, there is the possibility that international broadcast by private individuals will be prohibited. Incidentally this was reproduced on the "back side" of a McIntire pitch for funds, hi.

SAR: Missed your report last month.

First off congratulations to Bill Sparks on his fine pinch hitching job. It's certainly nice to know that the ASWLC has this kind of talent to call upon. XXX with Bill Gardiner taking over as Executive Editor I expect "SWL" will be on time as of the October or November issue.

Now some items;

CANADA Broadcast Band station CFCF (Montreal 600 kc) now has strong signal here on 6000 kc during daylight hours here. Either this is a new SWBC facility or a king sized BCB harmonic (CMS)

CONGO REP In addition to 15190, R.Brazzaville is using a new 19M freq., 15230 at 1900-2200 w/Fr. & native (SAR ABA)

CUBA After some double checking with SHM, I find that the Cuban he heard on 9530 was probably not COCO but R.Habana Cuba. Off the record, this is strictly bush league reporting.

DOMINICAN REP. First, there is a new 120M station on the air - R.Santa Maria 2380 kc. Next during the military takeover of IX/25 & 26, R.Santo Domingo 9505 was heard throughout the day acting as government mouthpiece. They were apparently relayed by some stations in other Dominican towns but none of the other regulars (BCB, 120 or Short Wave) were heard here. Today IX/27 R.Santo Domingo itself is missing at 1600-1730 possibly due to the hurricane or maybe broadcasting has simply returned to normal.....oh yes, I can't find Santa Maria on any maps but it is apparently near La Vega (CMS)

ETHIOPIA ETLF R.Voice of the Gospel hrd on new 9755 at 1500 w/Fr. to Madagascar (ABA)

SWEDEN "Sweden Calling DXers" is now carried Tuesday GMT instead of Mondays (SAR) (BLR: I do receive these scripts but irregularly so your help is most appreciated)

RUANDA Deutsche Welle announces that itself a relay in this African republic. Initially it will have only 600 watts but eventually 100 KW on ~~XX~~ 7200 kc w/Eng at 0430-0500 & 0605-0635. This is from Ray Fronczak. Can anyone clarify or confirm this report?

USA WINB has moved its 16M XMR down to 17730 kc. The station now produces its own 5 minute news commentary at 2005 (CMS)

BLR: Thanks for lending me that booklet. Will return in about a week. I am putting it to good use, hi.

CAIRO AND "HONEY HONEY"

R.Cairo was first noted on a new frequency of 11690A on XI/18. On that same date the station playing "Honey Honey" on 11697 disappeared. During this period Cairo could be hrd around 2000 //7070. However on XII/25A modulation on 11690A became very weak and the station could only be monitored, if at all, around 1700. Then on I/11 "Honey Honey" reappeared at 1405 w/fair strength and good modulation. In view of this, Cairo and HH probably have no connection with each other but these are a strange set of coincidences (SAR/Ø CMS)

HEADLINE.....VATICAN RADIO

Vatican R was heard I/8 at 2230 on new 7260 w/Eng for the Philippines (GKL/2) THIS COULD BE THERE NEW PHILIPPINES RELAY which was reported in the work§ some time ago.

HEADLINE.....IRAN

R.Tehran has been hrd testing two new 100 KW XMTRs after 1500 on 7135//9695 (SAR/Ø)ABA/6) As noted last month, "Honey Honey" and the communist R.Teje Iran use the same frequencies at the same time.

- AFGHANISTAN Contrary to a recent WRN bulletin, Kabul's 1400-1430 Eng is still on 4775A.. Audible several days during early January (HLC/6)
- ALBANIA R.Tirana has a 20 KW home svc.relay on 6600 at 1300-1400 and 1730-2000 (R.SWEDEN via BLR/2)
- ARGENTINA Trans Radio, Buenos Aires hrd w/Eng & Spanish test tape at 1510 on 18450A. Compania Internacional del Radio, Buenos Aires logged at 0635 on 12190 (NYC/2)
- AUSTRALIA A.B.C.'s "Morning Show" is being hrd at 2000-2100 and later on 15315 (GKL/2) R.Australia's 2215 S/On in Eng for Asia audible on 11840 kc, SINPO 45433 (SHM/6)
- BRAZIL ZYZ26 R.Globo 6035 kc S/Off is 0300, ZYS44 R.Parana 3365 S/Off is 0230 and ZYS8 R.Amazonas 4805 kc S/Off is 0305 (WSP/6)
- CHINA As of XII/27 Peking was carrying R.Tirana 0030-0055 NA svc on 9470//9865 (SAR/Ø) Peking is often hrd on 6000 at 1400 w/powerful signals. This was reported, probably in error, as a new channel for R.Kabul (HLC/6)
- CONGO REP. R.Brazzaville now seems to have two completely different Fr. networks. Hrd on 19M - 15190 & 15370 both after 1700 (BLR/2 ABA/6)
- COSTA RICA Currently R.Reloj is hrd on 6206.5M and R.Periodica on 6210A (RHU/1 NYC/2) R.Reloj is a move from 6006 (R.SWEDEN via BLR/2) and R.Periodica appeared to have taken over R.Monumental's XMTR.

- DENMARK The Voice of Denmark has a new Eng XMSN to NA at 1200-1300 on 15165 (NYC/2)
- DOMINICAN REP. R.Santo Domingo has moved it's 90M XMTR to 3250, noted poorly at 0300 (NYC/2) and has put a XMTR on 60M at 4815. First hrd XII/11 at 0515. Meanwhile as of XII/19 R.San Pedro has moved from 2400A to 3212.9M. Just to make things more interesting the Dominican Telephone Co.was mobtored XII/11 in 60M broadcast territory on 4796M at 0508 w/SBB test XMSN (RHU/1) Finally according to an NRC report, R.Samba Maria hrd regularly on 2380A would be a harmonic of BCBer NIBV (CMS)
- ECUADOR Radio Telephone y Telegraph del Ecuador logged w/test tape at 1305 on 15605, SINPO 55555 (NYC/2)
- EGYPT R.Cairo can be hrd w/Eng news at 0644 on 6800A (NYC/2) X7777 - would you double check that frequency fellows.
- ETHIOPIA RTLF's Eng to S.Africa on 9705 made it into the U.S. XII/30 at 1835-1920 (SAR/6)
- GABON Libreville 4775 logged XII/31 w/Fr. at 0550 (WSP/6)
- GERMANY WEST As of XII'19 Deutsche Welle had moved it's 1630 Eng to 11815 from 11785 (WSP/6) Deu.Poste at Frankfurt logged w/test tape on 6820 at 0742. M.U.S.Army station AEA at Tannison hrd w/test tape at 2310 on 7550A (NYC/2) XM
- GREECE The Greek Forces station is now on 7340 from 7215 (R.SWEDEN via BLR/2)
- GUATEMALA The new station on 11700 is R.Norte at Puerto Barrios (CMS)
- GUINEA Conakry has moved it's 31M XMTR down 5 ke to 9645 and is now in the clear (of VOA) until 2400 S/Off, as of XII/16 (ABA/6) And on XII/21 the 49M XMTR had also moved down 5 ke to 6150, noted at 0630 //3385(WSP/6)
- HAWAII RCA Kahuku Pt.logged w/test tape at 1720 18870X. Verified by letter from 66 Broad St., NYC 4 (NYC/2)
- HONDURAS HRST R.Primo de Maio 4790 ke logged at 0300 S/Off XII/31 (WSP/6)
- INDIA A.I.R.'s 1525-1545 Eng is being hrd on 5955 (WSP/6 ABA/6) Another Eng XMSN is hrd at 1015-1100 on 11710, and the 0115 Eng S/On is received via N7250 (ABA/6)
- INDONESIA R.R.I. has a new Eng XMSN at 2330-0000 on 9865 followed by an hour of Indonesian (ABA/6 WSP/6) Note that this offband frequency is also used by Peking.
- IRAQ R.Baghdad 1455AX S/On in Arabia was audible in XMinu XII/27 on 6095 ke as was the Kurdish XMSN on 6030 (SAR/6) (I'd like to see a sunspot count for those last 10 days of 63) Incidentally, "Honey Honey" has been tentatively logged in Europe on 6095 prior to R.Baghdad's S/ON (R.SWEDEN/BLR)
- ISRAEL Kol Israel's H 9625 has been rec.in NA //9009 at 1900 XII/21 w/Arabic (?) (BLR/2) I/1 w/Roumanian (SAR/6)
- JAMAICA Cable & Wireless (W.I.) Ltd.near Kingston hrd on 11600A at 2155 concluding test tape (simple AM modulation) then calling Panama (NYC/2)
- JORDAN M.B.S. (R.Amman) noted I/1 on new 9530 after M.B.I. S/Off at 1600. Amman in Arabic (SAR/6)
- MALI Since XII/12 Bamako has been hrd on new 9745 at 0600-0800, 1700-1900 and 2100-2300. Apparently replaces 7145 (ABA/6) Another new frequency is 3380A hrd XII/31 at 0600 S/On //4835 (WSP/6)
- MARTINIQUE R.Martinique 3315 Port de France normal S/Off is 30215 exc.Sat & holidays when it is 0415 (WSP/6) French Telecommunications Service hrd on 19500A hrd calling Paris N7via Fr.& Eng tape at 1152 (NYC/2)
- MEXICO La Paz telephone station noted on 11690A at 1946 calling Guadelajara (CMS)

MOZAMBIQUE ER.Clube de Mocambique is now using new 6050 kc for its Commercial svc ~~XX~~ starting at 0330 but only can be hrd in U.S. at 0400-0430 while HCJB is off. This is //3835 (WSP/6) (Believe 3835 should be 4835 - CMS)

NEW BRITAIN ISLAND (Papua Territory) 7L9RB R.Rabaul 4840 logged while barely audible XI/22 at 0900 beginning at 0900 (WSP/6)

NIGERIA According to announcements hrd XII/24 R.Nigeria (N.B.C.) is using their new ~~XX~~ 100 KMM XNTRS to relay the commercial svc at 1100-2000 on 11910 (actually 11900 - ABA/6 WSP/6) and the home svc at 1300-2000 on 15255 (Reported last month as actually 15180). The schedule however still appears to be quite irregular (BLR/2)

PHILIPPINES DUN2 Philippines Broadcasting Service has boosted power on 6170 and as of 1/4 can be hrd in WCNA at 0815-0900. Sometimes IDs simply as PBS, other times has complete ID in Eng (WSP/6)

POLAND Warsaw telephone station logged w/Eng test tape on 7400A at 2100(NYC2)

SAUDI ARABIA Jeddah bagged on 9670 at 1430-1500 w/fair to good signals (GKL/2) tentatively at 1600-1700 in Arabic w/QRM from Colombo about 2 or 3 kc down (WSP/6)

TANGANYIKA R.Tanganyika 5050 Dar-es-Salaam logged XII/12 0345-0440 fade out (HLC/6 WSP/6 who notes S/On is 0315, and by ALB)

USA WWV has a new system of codes (details please? - CMS) and now uses 24 hour system for EST (BLR/2)

USSR Khabarovsk on 3995 logged XII/12 in Russian at ~~XXXX~~ w/QRM from R.Liberty on 3990 (RHU/1) 0705

VENEZUELA R.Monagas logged XII/10 on new 2420.6M at 0432 S/off (RHU/1)

FINLAND According to SBC, Helsinki's new Eng sked is Fri at 1500-1700 on 9555//15185, 2100-2200 on 6020, and Sat at 1215-1315 on 9555 //11805//15185.

IVORY COAST R.Abidjan now S/On 0600 on new 3240//regular 4940 (WSP/6)

MONACO R.Monte Carlo 7135 Sat S/On is 0500, other days 0530 (WSP/6)

Does anyone know if TWR is still using this stations XMTRs?

REUNION St.Dennis has verified HLC/6's reception I/5 on 4807 kc.

MYSTERY A station is hrd on 6047 kc transmitting the letter L continuously in Al cw. Occasionally another letter is substituted for brief periods. It was first noted by Jim Howard and is now rec by your editor both night and day (but not before 1700). A combination of Fraud Finder measurements, the process of elimination and limitations on daytime ~~SW~~ 49M reception suggest that it's location is near the Mexican border not west of Arizona, or in Mexico itself. I have written to the FCC.

SPAIN U.S.Navy station AOK at ~~MAZE~~ Rota noted II/28 w/V marker at 1745. For some reason this marker is unusually difficult to copy (CMS)

SWITZERLAND Time station HSN Neuchatel logged II/16 on 5000 kc at 0020A thru heavy WWV & MUF QRM. This station has cw IDs at 05, 15, 25 etc. minutes past the hour (BLR/2)

THAILAND R.Thailand resumed it's 1700-1800 XMSN to NA II/13 after being off since I/1 (ABA/6)

MALAYSIA VPW+ Singapore is supposed to have a marine weather broadcast on 8762.2 kc at 0145. Do any of you West Coasters here this one?

Sam Rowell has moved to Big Harbor, Washington so we will now have a regular reporter from 7 land.

ALBANIA/CHINA R.Peking is hrd from 2200 on 7030A w/Russian and at the same time on 6880 w/Portuguese. These do not come from the same XMR site and one may be that reported Albanian relay. Bears more FF checking. Meanwhile a Chicago member reports that Tirana's 0030-0055 XMSN to the Americas (he says Argentina) is on 9470 (a Peking relay of course) but //7088 which is Tirana's own frequency. Anybody else here the latter???

BURMA B.B.S. ~~XXXXXX~~ 6035 kc now has it's Eng news at 1445-1500, S/OffX at 1600 (ABA)

CONGO REP O.R.T.F., Brazzaville for it's 1900-2100 Fr. 11725 has been replaced by 11930, //15370 (ABA)

FRANCE From XI/20 thru XI/20, O.R.T.F. will be conducting a vast series of SW tests. The schedule for the U.S.A. (which for some mysterious reason is entirely in Fr) is on 9755 at 0700-0830 (a ridiculous time)K and 2000-2100. In fact their choice of languages is absolutely incomprehensible. For example to the USSR at 2000-2045 on 6175, they use Eng, Spanish & Portuguese. Needless to say, they want reports.

ITALY ABA notes that R.A.I. ~~XX~~'s 0920 Eng news was audible X/24 on 9710.

NETH. ANTILLES T.W.R. is using 9710 for an evening (EST) svc. Eng news at 0230. Meanwhile as of XI/8 the Sunday XMSNs have been moved to 11860 (BLR/

TAIWAN New frequencies for Voice of Free China's 0250-0350 XMSN to NA are 17890//11534 (ABA)
