- 2340v 0357* UnID LA, best after 0330; rather confusing. LA music and lots of Brazilian-sounding accordion music, occasional slogan like R Popular or R Tropical. Heard 0357 s/off on 12-8 and 12-9 with anthem; thought Ecuadorian anthem on 12-9, but it's merely similar. Also have heard mention of Bogota here, and a possible mention of Itacoatiara. Poor in QRN most of the time. (Perdue)
- 2390 0200 MEXICO - R Huayacocotla, heard very well this night with usual Mexican music program and IDs by M&W. Had not been heard for a week or so. (Perdue 12-9)
- 3211 0302 MOZAMBIQUE - R Mozambique, down here after being on 3216 for a while, noted with strong signals, news dual 4865.5 which was also good, on top of Brazil. (McNeil)
- 3275 VENEZUELA - Jack Jones advises that the AA program previously reported here on R Mara is for Arabic workers in Venezuelan oil fields. (Perdue)
- 3285 2130 BRAZIL - R Olinda, good with ad string, religious program 2140, more ads 2155. Full ID 2159, into A Voz do Brasil at 2200, but considerably weaker. (Berg)
- 3290 1808 MADAGASCAR - Tananarive, nice flute music with native singing, FF talks by M ancr. (Kuznecovs 12-2)
- 3375 0456 ANGOLA - R Nacional, local choral music, language talk by M, mention of Angola. Fair in QRN. No sign of anything on other frequencies. (Harry Jones 12-10)
- 3411 *1000 BRAZIL - R Xapuri, showing these days at *1000v, often closer to 1008. Still poor signal, but should improve. Gives TC as part of s/on amt. (Berg)
- 0212 - Light song, DJ in with song title, TC, ID and into program of Brazilian pop music. Good with line noise. First time in quite a while. (McNeil 12-9)
- 3425 0101 NEPAL - R Nepal, surprised to hear at all, much less this late, with chants and flutes, M in apparent Nepali. Good at start, but poor by 0145. (Krueger 12-1)
- 3995 1226 USSR (Asiatic RSFSR) - Nikolayevsk-na-Amure, regular now with classical music, M2 IS at 1229; fair. (Krueger 12-1)
- 3995 1039 USSR (Asiatic RSFSR) - Kyzyl, M1 program, W ancr giving program details on records to be played, dual 5015. (Kuznecovs 12-3)
- 4050 1232 USSR (Kirghiz SSR) - Frunze, M1 program, talks mixed with musical items. (Kuznecovs 12-2)
- 4130 2242 CHINA - R Beijing, local orchestral music, W with straight talks in possible Lao or Thai, M with short talk 2254, into Internationale to 2257*. Fair-good with noise. Listed in TBS-5 for 2130*. (McNeil 12-20)
- 4500 1130 CHINA - Urumqi listed, M&W talk in slugging match with VNG time signal. Frequently heard this season, but best at 1130 on 12-3. (Ferrell)
- 4635 0304 USSR (Tadzhik SSR) - Dushanbe, very strong with M in RR, seeming IS-type chime, M&W with RR talks. Carrying M1 apparently, as dual 4895 Tyumen. (McNeil 12-19)
- 1145 - Fair signals with lots of poah flutter, heavy Russian march music. Fairly regular around this time in subsequent checks. (McNeil 12-2)
- 1215 - Long RR talk on agricultural problems, also heard on 4975 which was presumably relaying this. (Kuznecovs 12-2)
- 4675 1058 UnID, caught here for a minute with EE ads for "Mortein Flyspray"; Pacific area, as far as accent goes; off 1059. (Kuznecovs 12-2)
- 4697 0320 BOLIVIA - R Riberalta, continuous SS LA ballads, few with a local flavor. Weak, but very clear. (Krueger 12-2)
- 4700 *1200 UnID, still eluding me here. Weak carrier and some modulation. Bothered by periodic SSB net. Obvious s/on at 1200. Help! (Ferrell 12-12)
- 4707 1130 UnID, still being heard from time to time, though very weak. Al Sizer is probably correct in that the heard times indicate Asian origin. Usually barely audible between 1130 and 1215. (Ferrell)
- 4717.5 1150 INDONESIA (Sulawesi) - RRI Ujung Pandang, pop music, talk by M. Islands music at 1156, SCI (Song of the Coconut Islands) at 1159. Fair in RTTY. (Harry Jones)
- 1140 - Talk and music; fair signal strength, but it didn't matter much as there was a super-powerful utility station clicking away on the frequency. What a shame! (Gavaras 11-28)
- 4729v 0324 UnID LA, showed up here on 12-15, fairly nice local music, SS DJ with talks, few ads. Fair signal. Not Riberalta, which was heard at the same time on 4696.

- 4729v 0324 Not heard at 1135; but in by 2330 the same evening, with SS talks - news, it seemed - "Andean" music. Fair signals, but almost never clear of ute QRM. Ideas? (McNeil)
- 4740 0350* NUMBERS - The "March from Aida" station heard previously by Jerry Berg and myself heard 0341 playing the march, then 0345 W in Slavic language with numbers, 0349 OC, and off 0350. (McNeil 12-19)
- 4760h 1230 USA - A real live Hauser-type harmonic! Giving nationwide weather report at 1230, frequent mentions of Waynesboro. Beats me, since it wasn't there at 1200. (Ferrell) Would have to be 4x1190 - any solutions, Bob Foxworth? FH
- 4770t 1740 LIBERIA - ELWA, M with religious sermon, world news at 1800. ELWA is the only thing that makes sense; if so, the earliest 60 m log ever here, from 11:40 a.m. to noon local time. (Perdue 12-4)
- 4774v *1258 AFGHANISTAN - Kabul, s/on with OC, then audio sort of faded in, with Middle East style march music, M in language. Had to depart quickly to catch a ride to school thereafter. Quite strong signals, and is fairly regular at s/on, but I can never stick around for more program details. No RRI Jakarta lately. (McNeil)
- 0245 - Strong, subcontinental music with tablas and sitar, man wailing, W ancr. Subcontinental music at 0323 retune, M&W 0330, off 0331*, still fair to good. (McNeil 12-19) Pitt caught the end of an exceptional over-the-pole opening. FH
- 4780 1110 VENEZUELA - La Voz de Carabobo, LA ballads, etc. (Jack Jones 12-4)
- 4780 1141 HONDURAS - R Juticalpa, ID, TC, ranchera music, ads; fading fast. (Jack Jones)
- 4780 0535 USSR (Karelian ASSR) - Petrozavodsk, vocals, time pips 0600 into news by M&W. Very good. (Krueger 12-1)
- 1155 - Strong unmodulated carrier, time tick at 1200 and Mayak ID, man into RR news. Better than average signal. (Ferrell 11-27)
- 4784.5 2100* TANZANIA - Dar-es-Salaam, poor-fair signal in ute QRM 2040, M in Swahili, local pops. 2055 brief news by M, 2059:30 different M with s/off anmts, then NA 2100 and off. (Whitacre 12-8)
- 0412 - Astounding near-local signal with M in Swahili, chants and flute music. (Krueger 12-1)
- 4785 0406 USSR (Azerbaijan SSR) - Baku, apparent RR news feed, local language (like Farsi). with W from 0409 including chants accompanied by santour/dumbas instruments. Do not confuse with Tanzania! Very good. (Krueger 12-8)
- 2110 - Opera music, M in RR. Fair in RTTY QRM. (Harry Jones 12-8)
- 4787 2100 DOMINICAN REPUBLIC - R Norte, heard regularly now 2100-0200+ with LA music, ads, TCs. Plenty mentions of República Dominicana, but kinda stingy with the IDs. (Perdue)
- 4807 2302* SAO TOME - R Nacional de Sao Tome e Principe, 2246 fast flute music and PP talk. 2259 ID by a M, 2300 NA, carrier off 2302. Poor signal with severe QRM. (Gavaras 11-29)
- 4810 0100 ECUADOR - La Voz de Galapagos, still here most nights 0100-0230+, US and LA music, IDs, good. (Perdue)
- 4815 0324 PERU - R Samaren, ID, TC, easy-listening LA and US music. (Jack Jones 12-7)
- 4820 2013 ANGOLA - Maputo, speech on independence. (Kuznecovs 12-6)
- 4825.5 0306* GUATEMALA - R Mam, strong, strange a capella wailing by W. Full ID with call letters, frequency, QTH; marimba music interlude, then s/off without NA. (Harry Jones 12-3)
- 4840 *1229 INDIA - AIR Bombay, after several mornings of weak signals and bad FFBS QRM at s/on, finally in good enough on 12-3, 1229 s/on with SOI IS, W in language with talks, into news in what seemed to be EE, then language talks by M. A short cut of local music, then straight talks by M&W past 1255. (McNeil)
- 4840 1150 CHINA - Fuzhou, CC talk by M, good. (Harry Jones 12-3)
- 4843 2104* CONGO - Pointe Noire, good with pleasant melodic instrumental music, FF W at 2100 with ID, more music, short talk by M, NA and off. (McNeil 12-2)
- 2105* - Tentative, very poor signal, briefly 2100 with weak fady signal, het on strong Mauritania-4845. M ancr in language, then definite NA-type music just before s/off. First log in afternoon here. (Whitacre 12-8)
- 4844 0055 HONDURAS - R San Ysidro, Catholic mass, Christmas music, M ancr with full ID 0114, "Aqui Honduras, Radio San Ysidro." More Xmas music, LA music, ID 0152.

- 4844 0055 Good, some QSB. Should be fairly regular through Christmas. Oft-repeated slogan of "Eee-men-cion" or similar. Heard past 0200. (Perdue 12-4,5)
- 0004 - Central American music, DJ, full ID with location; off when back at 0011. (McNeil 12-21)
- 4850 0130 ECUADOR - Ondas del Zamora, LA and US music, overmodulation anmts and IDs; good. (Perdue 12-8)
- 4850 0100 VENEZUELA - R Capital, well heard here again with wide variety of music, IDs, singing "Capital" IDs. (Perdue)
- 1025 - Talks, mention of Venezuela; ad for banco. LA pop music, singing ID and TC at 1030. Very good. Back on as of this date and since. (Harry Jones 12-5)
- 4850 1205 USSR (Uzbek SSR) - Tashkent, RR talk by M&W, good with flutter. Clarin and Capital off. (Harry Jones 12-3)
- 1201 - RR news by M&W, strong signals with a dual-path echo, probably over-the-Pacific and over-the-pole. China underneath. (McNeil 12-4)
- 4850 2305 CHINA - CPBS-2, quite strong 2305-2330 f/out with mostly CC talks by M&W, some music. First time heard in this time period. (McNeil 12-14)
- 4852.5 0412 YEMEN - R Sanaa, though no trace at 0300, here strong with M talking on some political event in AA. (Krueger 12-1)
- 4855 1155 INDONESIA (Sumatera) - RRI Palembang, Indonesian music with Moslem flavor, talk, SCI at 1200. Fair with fades. (Harry Jones 12-3)
- 1156 - Best ever with talk by a W, into an enchanting song by a W, W with ID, SCI, six pips, "Warta berita dan Jakarta," by M at 1200. Made a real nice tape. (McNeil 12-4)
- 4860 0345 USSR - R Moscow, M1 in RR 0345-0406+, dual 4895 Tyumen. Not EE feeder to Bulgaria as usually heard. Fair, with Chinchaycocha down about 50 Hz and another LA on 4859.9 lost in the mess. Maracaibo was off. (McNeil 12-19)
- 4860 1145 USSR - RM, Chita reactivated? Classical opera selections, M in RR, 1159 OC; no IS heard, pips 1200, W&M in news. Not dual M1 on 4780. Good, fluttery. (McNeil 12-19)
- 4860 0259 USSR (European RSFSR) - R Moscow, Kalinin, IS into EE feeder to Bulgaria for NA, weak level under the Venezuelan. (Krueger 12-2)
- 4860t 0400* ECUADOR - R Mundial, mention of "Republica del Ecuador" in plenty of QRM, very short version of NA. Chinchaycocha in immediately after carrier off. Thanks to tentative tip from Tom Alleman. (Perdue 12-4)
- 4865 1300 UnID, fairly strong carrier with 1000 Hz tone from 1300 to 1315; switched over to 3000 Hz tone for a minute or two. Second station carrier jumped on top at 1317. No idea what's going on. Definitely polar flutter as the two faded out around 1330. (Ferrell 12-2)
- 4865 2012 MOZAMBIQUE - Maputo, PP song by W singer, accordion music. (Kuznecovs 12-7)
- 4870 0200* ECUADOR - R Rio Amazonas, M with closing anmts, NA. Have now heard this one s/off at 0200, 0300, 0320 and 0330. Quite variable, I'd say. (Perdue)
- *1123 - NA, distinctive solo chanting by W, sometimes M, lasting to 1133 t/out. ID may have been before anthem. (Jack Jones 12-1)
- 4870 2009 BENIN - Cotonou, EE news by W ancr, mentioned People's Republic of Mongolia. (Kuznecovs 12-7)
- 4895 0400 USSR - Tyumen, after not being heard last season, is all of a sudden quite easy. 1130 In with good signals 0400-0530 f/out, though lots of flutter, and strong 1130-1200 with less flutter. Carries M1 dual Petrozavodsk 4780/5065, usual RR songs, classical music, RR talks. (McNeil)
- 4905 2300* CHINA - CPBS-1 Nanning, still regular after 2200 with mostly just talks, bits of Oriental music, off abruptly at 2300*. QRM Relogio-4905.5. (McNeil)
- 4908.5 1135 KAMPUCHEA - Phnom Penh, strongest signal ever recorded or logged from this station 1135-1150. Lots of singing. (Ferrell 12-12) Is that what they call a Phnom-Penh-al signal? FH
- 4910 0515 ECUADOR - Emisora Gran Colombia, LA music, "Emisora Gran Colombia de la capital" ID. Strong, but het and poor modulation. (Perdue 12-8)
- 4910 1820 ZAMBIA - Lusaka, lengthy talk by two M on internal affairs, mentioned places in Zambia; in vernacular. (Kuznecovs 12-2)

- 4920 1238 INDIA - AIR Madras, poor signal under Brisbane, W wailing with definite subcontinental musical accompaniment; listed 1235* in TBS. (Whitacre 12-2)
- 4924 0900 BRAZIL - Rdif Taubate, religious program, into talks by DJ. Clear ID at 0912. Fair-good, but quick fadeout. (Harry Jones 12-10)
- 4930 0455 USSR (Georgian SSR) - Tbilisi, very strong, at first thought it was Radio Mil. Mountain folk music, M2 IS at 0500, then W in RR. (Harry Jones 12-9)
- 0302 - RR news by W, at least as strong as Radio Mil. (McNeil 12-19)
- 4935 2235 BRAZIL - R Capixaba, in earlier than usual with typical program of accordion and LA tunes, M ancr with overmodulated, reverberating anmts, IDs. "Machine-gun" QRM, but QF-1 notched most of it out. (Ferdue 12-4)
- 4935 1245* PAKISTAN - Islamabad, back again here as last winter, but not as strong. Best after 1200, though in before then, with chants, language talks, news. S/off at 1245v* is same as last winter, too. (McNeil)
- *1125 - IS and s/on at 1129. Fairly decent signal strength. (Ferrell 12-12)
- 1205 - Chanting, local music, poor. (Harry Jones 12-3)
- 4940 0357 USSR (Ukrainian SSR) - Kiev, classical impressionistic piano music, into W in Ukrainian. Good and very clear. (Harry Jones 12-9)
- 0435 - Semi-classical music, W ID 0500 as "Hovorit Kiev" and into Ukrainian news. Very good. (Krueger 12-1)
- 0400 - Loud and clear 0400-0530+, all local programming, with quite interesting folk music; never heard anything like it before. Presumed Ukrainian talks. (McNeil)
- 4946v 1130 VIETNAM - Hanoi, jumping all over the place, down as far as 4939, and as of 12-15 on this frequency. Strong just about every morning, regardless of conditions, 1130-1230 in checks; mostly VV talks. (McNeil)
- 4957.6 0336 USSR (Azerbaijan SSR) - Baku, light music, chorus, M with RR talk, talks by M&W; strong but ute QRM. First time heard. (McNeil 12-19) This is really something-first reception report I can recall from NA. FH
- 4960 0325 ECUADOR - R Federacion, slow ballads, past 0335; a mess in het and QRM. ID at 0331. (Ferdue 12-8)
- 4963 1130 VIETNAM - Hanoi, sticking very close to this measured frequency for the past 8 to 10 days. Nice signal on 11-30 at 1130 with usual sing-song W and pleasant music. (Ferrell)
- 4975 1602* USSR (Asiatic RSFSR) - Blagoveschensk, M1 program, RR news read by M&W 1011, another day at s/off with NA 1602*. At times is heard as early as 0830 with local programming. (Kuznecovs 12-2.5)
- 4976 2033 UGANDA - Kampala, vernacular program with M&W, drums at 2033. (Kuznecovs 12-4)
- 4980 0400 SWAZILAND - SCR, "Radio Truro", subcontinental flute music, ID by M in EE as "Radio Truro in Southern Africa." Ads, including Peter Stuyvesant cigars. (Ferdue 11-24)
- 4990 1900 SOUTH AFRICA - SABC heard here with PP program dual 11900; this outlet is well heard here in Adelaide 1856-1950. (Kuznecovs)
- 4994 1220 VIETNAM - Hanoi, good signal with M in Asian language, SEA music and female vocals. (Whitacre 12-6)
- 5010 1031 COLOMBIA - R Surcolombiana, TC, ID, "Musica de Huila." (Jack Jones 12-4)
- 5010 2158* CAMEROUN - R Garoua, M&W ancres, African chanting, ME/African type music. Mentions of Cameroun. Best about 2130, then going downhill. RTTY QRM, some QSB and het. Off with anthem or march 2158*. (Ferdue 12-4)
- 5015 0525 USSR (European RSFSR) - Arkhangelsk, semi-classical music, M2 IS 0529, into RR talk by W. Weak. (Krueger 12-8)
- 5024.3 0330 BRAZIL - R Borborema, PP DJ, TC at 0334, Beatles oldie, other easy-listening pops. Ads, ID at 0342. Strong but somewhat muffled audio. (Harry Jones 12-10)
- 5025 1057 PERU - R Quillabamba, music, ID, calls, frequencies, followed by anthem, talk, music, and f/out. Splendit not on. Could have been s/on. (Jack Jones 11-30)
- 5026 2036 UGANDA - Kampala, National program, heard same time as 4976 with choir singing carols. (Kuznecovs 12-4)
- 5033 *0527 ANGOLA - Emissora Regional da Cabinda, carrier on 0522, 0527 IS of local music, 0529 short NA. S/on by M in PP 0530 with ID, into talks. Poor-fair in QRM. (Harry Jones 12-10) Excellent, Harry! FH

- 5035 0233 USSR (Kazakh SSR) - Alma Ata, strong, CC talks by M&W, apparently relaying R Peace & Progress. Still good at 0307 in CC but faded by 0335. (McNeil 12-19)
- 1227 - IS until program opening at 1230. Agrees with sked of Tashkent relay at this time period. Heard best on 11-26. (Ferrell)
- 5038 2302* CENTRAL AFRICAN EMPIRE - Bangui, 2239 FF talk (sounded like the "emperor"), 2241 NA, into some fast African-style instrumental music, then some American disco songs. 2300 ID and s/off, 2302 NA. Fair-good signal. (Gavaras 12-1)
- 5050 1204 TANZANIA - Dar-es-Salaam, Swahili news, mixed with QRM. (Kuznecovs 12-6)
- 5052 1130 SINGAPORE - R Singapore, not being heard this year as strong and as frequently as last year. Surprised me on 12-4 with a good signal, though some het. 1130 time tick and W reading classified ads or news items. (Ferrell)
- 5055.5 0845 BRAZIL - R Educadora Sobral, talk by M, religious music, ID at 0857. Mention of Sobral. Good signal but fades to nothing by 0915. (Harry Jones 12-15)
- 5060 1300 PAKISTAN - Islamabad, W reading EE news after 1300. Not usually heard here, but had good clean signal. (Ferrell)
- 1232 - Noted with strong signals, seemed to be Koran readings, then M with news 1234 in Urdu. Even stronger at 1257 check with chanting/wailing. Quite remarkable, as last winter all subcontinental stations faded out by 1300. (McNeil 12-2)
- 5065 0300 USSR (Karelian ASSR) - Petrozavodsk, back regularly with the winter solstice approaching. Can be heard at just about any hour from 0300-1300 f/out, with ML programming dual stronger 4780. (McNeil)
- 5873 *1100 HONDURAS - La Voz de Honduras, coming in regularly now, though almost always suffering heavy CW QRM from NSS-5870, also pretty deep fading. S/on varies: usually 1100, but 1115 one day, and on at 1054 another. Has news from the military government at 1130, and often IDs as "HRN". (Berg)
- 5920 1200 NICARAGUA - Rdif Nacional, now reactivated on this frequency, clear of QRM, in the mornings at least. 1200-1400 f/out with nice marimba music, DJ in after every song with TCs and occasional IDs. Strong signals: S9+40 on my conservative meter. (McNeil 12-9)
- 5945 0228 NICARAGUA -Rdif Nacional, talks with audience clapping, many names mentioned. Many "Radiodifusora Nacional" IDs; continued until 0337, then music with an ID between each song. 0359 ID as Rdif Nac de Nicaragua, more music. Excellent signal. (Gavaras 12-4)
- 1241 - Again on with SS TCs, marimba instrumentals. Good. (Krueger 12-7)
- 1157 - Strong signal but covered by intense OC, sometimes breaking into fast CW. ID, TC, MoR music. (Jack Jones 12-2)
- 5955 1056 COLOMBIA - La Voz de los Centauros, LA music programming. (Jack Jones 12-4)
- 5987 1335 INDONESIA (Sulawesi) - RRI Menado, talks, then into program of easy-listening Indonesian songs with a couple of DJ interruptions. Into Indo news(?) at 1400½. Good at first, by 1400 still fair; unusual this late. (McNeil 12-9)
- 6015 0820 BRAZIL - R Clube Pernambuco, Brazilian pop music, ads, talk; ID at 0835. Weak and fading with het. (Harry Jones 12-15)
- 6075 1141 HONDURAS - La Voz del Junco, ID, slogan, "le frecuencia del oro", pop music. (Jack Jones 11-30)
- 6115 1127 COLOMBIA - La Voz del Llano, singing Coke ad, "feliz navidad de Coca-Cola" ID, calls, frequency. (Jack Jones 12-7)
- 6200 *0830 CLANDESTINE - Voice of Communist Party of Turkey, audible again for our summer, s/on about 0830 on a Sunday, Turkish anmts and music, to f/out or s/off 0900. Only audible at this time period during our summer. (Padula 12-4)
- 6280 1105 CHINA - Urumqi listed, CC talk, orchestral music; fair. Seemed too strong for Sinkiang. (Harry Jones 12-7)
- 7275 1110 CHINA - Guiyang listed, CC talks, choral music, fair. (Harry Jones 12-15)
- 7085 2311* CLANDESTINE - R Abdalla, M in emphatic SS attack on communists at great level with bad audio, to 2311*. Also IDed as "Radio Libertad de Cuba" - probably from South Florida, where countless numbers of these kind do these things. Probably same as "Radio Rebelde Cubana" heard in March 76. (Krueger 12-4)
- 0202 - Heard a second time with ten-note IS that sounds vaguely familiar. "Esta es Radio Abdalla..." Soon overcome by CW. (Berg 12-2)

- 7170 0608 NEW CALEDONIA - Noumea, FF talk and orchestral music. 0616 played in EE Lux Radio Theatre with Sunset Boulevard. 0619 back to FF talking, instrumental music and ID; dual 11710. Good signal. (Gavaras 12-1)
- 9515 0207 URUGUAY - SODRE, EE with ID, meter bands, and address as SODRE, Mercedes 823, Montevideo. Then talked about a tourist site, Uruguay National Administration Sports, and a new building. At 0214 SS ID and talk. Good signal. (Gavaras 11-28)
- 9560 0020 PERU - R Nacional, Peruvian music, ancr, ads, ID. Wiped out 0030 by HCJB s/on. (Perdue 11-28)
- 9569.5 1253 QATAR - Doha, ME music and chants, W ancr in AA, six pips at 1300, and then AA news. Fair in het with Spain-9570. (McNeil 12-5)
- 9634 0745 MOROCCO - RTVM, showing here, modern Western vocals 0745, into FF anmts 0800 and FF ID as "Radio-television Marocaine," then into Arabic music; via LP. This used to be on 7225 some months back, but not heard there recently. Channel is occupied by Iraq in the 0430-0500 period. Believe RTVM may s/on at 0600 but haven't been able to check at that time yet. (Padula 12-4)
- 9635 2000 IRAQ - Baghdad has been on this frequency for the External Svc, ex-9745, including EE 2000, GG 2030, FF 2130. Also noted in our afternoons around 0430-0500+ with AA service, presumed "Voice of the Masses" when dual 11723. Not to be confused with RTVM-9634. (Padula 12-4)
- 9745 0550 CAMEROUN - R Yaounde, excellent signal strength and audio with highlife music, then European-flavor music in FF. EE ID at 0602. (Harry Jones 12-10)
- 11835 2010 LIBERIA - ELWA, surprised to hear tuning signal, short ID, anmts in AA by M, then into AA religious program with prayers 2015, to f/out 2030. Severe QRM from VOA Greenville on 11830 and 11840. (Padula 12-3)
- 11840 *0345 SEYCHELLES - FEBA found here with AA *0345-0445*, ex-11865. (Padula 12-4)
- 11780 *1846 USA - WYFR, Okeechobee FL, after tip on DX Digest, here with carrier to IS 1855, ID as "This is your family radio, WYFR, Okeechobee, Florida, the USA." Low and unstable modulation. 11885 better in SS 2300, though audio suffered clipping. (Krueger 12-11)
- 15235 0400 INDIA - AIR noted here and on dual 15365 with Test Cricket broadcasts in Hindi, Australia v. India, 12-4. These outlets normally are used in the 0800-1000 period. (Padula 12-4)
- 15310 2100 GUINEA - Conakry, noted back here 2100 through 2315+ and still going strong; FF anmts and lively African rhythms. (Padula)

C. M. STANBURY (in Shortwave News Service)...Libya - The Mebo II which was originally in Tripoli harbor moved 8-11 to Derma near the Egyptian border. The original contract was for a period of six months which has now run out (around 11-1) and the transmissions have not been noted lately. They did for a time relay Libyan Radio English from Tripoli using a Grundig Satelit to pick them up but these transmissions were soon discontinued due to poor quality. The MW transmissions used only 10 kW although they had a 105 kW transmitter available... Malta - Deutsche Welle's 600 kW relay on 1570 kHz is airing an Arabic program produced by Libyan Radio at 2130. This is certainly a very strange alliance.
