"Boletin Noticias de Canarias." talk abt agriculture, mx, many IDs, 2-question quiz before NA and 0334\*. (Leithner, TN 11-27) CHILE RN, 6150, in SP 0245-0330; good. Political talk by M, ID 0300, into mx pgm of ballads. (Frank Orcutt, CA) CHINA FFBS 2, 3400, in CH 1110; very good. Nice CH opera mx, W anner talking. (Klein, NJ)+++ RP 6345, in RS 1000; RTTY ORM, IS and Govorit Pekin ID. This ORMs presumed Echo of Hope on 6348. (Rich Lucas, CA 11-23) CLANDESTINE LV de Verdade, 4950, hrd tnx to UD tip. Missed \*0330 (tuned in 0333) to hear PT low-key talk, mentioning OAU. Herb Alpert tune also noted. Fair. (Leithner, TN 11-26) COLOMBIA R. Neiva, 4855, in SP 5 Dec. Mx pgm w/ ID as Transmite R. Neiva; many ads. Fair. (Field, MI)\*\*\*Time, Marlin? tba\*\*\*LV del Cinaruco, 4865, in SP 0953-1032; good but overmodulated. IDs and TCs by W, ranchero mx, ads. (Orcutt, CA 11-29)+++Rdf. Nac. de Colombia, 5980, in SP 0953; vy good. Chimes or gongs, "el Eco Informo" pgm, possible s/on, not there a few minutes earlier. (Jones, MS 11-20)+++Ondas del Darien, in SP \*1015; good. March mx, ID, calls, freqs followed by NA. Somewhat distorted modulation. (Jones, MS 11-21) COSTA RICA R. Reloj, 6010, in SP 0232; vy good. Moving around? not on 49m anywhere at 1000 check. Hrd w/ nx. (Jones, MS 11-20)+++ R. Reloj, 5954, in SP 1037; vy good. ID, TC, patriotic slogan, ranchera mx. (Jones, MS 11-21)+++R. Nacional, 6035, in SP 1128-55; good but sometimes bothered by humming noise. Nx, at 0028 and into pgm of mainly old US pops w/ annomts by M 0031. Many TCs, a couple of IDs as R. Nacional and a couple of PSAs by government. (Lazarus, LA 11-20) \*\*\*The former printed as received. Do you mean 1128 or 0028, Henry? tba\*\*\*Same, 0227. Sounded like a political rally, speeches, applause, side commentary, etc. ID as R. Nacional de Costa Rica. Fair. (Jones, MS 11-20)---Same, 0044. John Lennon song, IDs. DW-6040 arrival at 0055 and AFRTS OC on 6030 reduced otherwise OK sig to miserable by 0100. (Leithner, TN 11-26)+++R. Rumbo, 6078, in SP 0221; good. Rumbo noticias, M&W alternating w/ nx items. (Jones, MS 11-20) ECUADOR R. Iris, 3380, in SP 1114; vy good. ID, TC, local mx. (Jones, MS 12-6)+++R. Jesus del Gran Poder, 5050, in SP 1104; vy good. Commercial and business nx. Annced several other stns in net carrying pgm. (Jones, MS 11-23)+++R. Progreso, 5060a, in SP 1012. Vy Good. ID, TC for 0508 local, talk, local mx. (Jones, MS 11-26) EL SALVADOR R. Nac. de El Salvador, 5980, in SP 0420; fair. LA mx heavily laced w/ propaganda. Freq clear but BBC-5975 troublesome, (Jones, MS 11-28) GERMANY (FED REP) SDR, 6030, in GM (naturlich); fair. EZL mx, M anner, talk, local annemts, more mx. (Klein, NJ) +++SFB, 6190, in GM 0853; good. Mixed bag of EzL mx and pops, M annor between w/ talk, etc. (Klein, NJ) GRENADA RFG, 15045, in EG 2230; fair. ID as Radio Free Grenada, TC and local nx. (Jones, MS) GUATEMALA R. Maya, 3325, in SP 1105; fair. M anner, religious talk, prayer and marimbas. HONDURAS R. Lux, 4890, in SP 0228; vy good. "Musica Nacional y Internacional." (Jones, MS 12-6) --- Same, 0115 w/ US pops, latin ballads, IDs. Heavy QRN made for difficult copy. (Leithner, TN 11-26)

\*\*\*IRELAND South Dublin R., 6240, in EG 0617-0705; pgm of pops and rock mx w/ annuments by M. Fairly strong and easy to hear mx but annuments difficult to understand because of high QRN. Address given twice as SDR, North St., Swords, County Dublin." (Lazarus, LA 12-6)---Same from 0600 w/ mx pgm, didn't recognize any of the songs. ID 0630 asked for rpts before that but no address. (Field, MI 12-6)\*\*\*See above, Marlin and good luck on the QSL. tba

LEBANON Vol., 6550, well heard fro, 0417; AR nx headlines, many sound effects (rooster crows and cuckoo clocks, ME and western mx w/ FR lyrics, IDs. Faded badly to out by 0515. (Leithner)

On 2 Dec fade in under UnID AR stn abt 0020, listened to after 0400. 3 days listening indicates that this is good choice being clear after 0100. (Lucas, CA 12-1)---Same 0322 and in well. Classical mx to 0358 when ID and into nx on hour. Deep fade. (Jack Reeder, MS)---And here as well regularly and very well after 0200. Am listening to it nightly for the sheer enjoyment of it. The local weather forecast after the 0300 nx is especially fun. A favorite of mine for years and glad to have it again. (tba)

(Lazarus, LA 11-27)---Same, various evenings after Brazil off 0300. Alway w/ mx pgm and different varieties I can't ID. Waht is QTH? (Field, MI)\*\*\*Don't know Marlin. Can we have an assist on that? tba\*\*\*Same, \*1036, fair. On w/ El Condor Pasa, annomt w/ clear ID, NA followed by usual local mx. Weak and slop from Jesus del Gran Poder. (Jones, MS 11-26)\*\*\*All stns should have such QRM trouble. tba\*\*\*R. Victoria, 6020, in SP 1045; fair. Ads, local mx. (Jones, MS 11-23)+++R. Chota presumed, 6295, in SP 0241-0322; LA mx w/ long annomts by M. Heard a few mentions of Peru and possibly one of Chota but could not pick out ID because of much static and QRM from code stn. (Lazarus, LA 11-20)+++ R. El Sol out of order on 5970, in SP 1008. Good. Fine Peruvian mx. Favorite W annor (the one w/ the husky voice). (Jones, MS 11-21)+++R. America also out of order, 6010, in SP 1030; fair. ID and MW freq (Mil diez kHz amplitude modulada). Bad het. (Jones, MS 11-27)

SINGAPORE RS, 5052, in EG 1045-1100; fair. Relig pgm "Evening Service," ad, tc and ID by W. (Orcutt, CA 11-29)

USSR Vladivostok, 5015, in RS 1059; fair. Mayak IS to hour, M&W anners w/ talk, the usual. (Klein, NJ)++R. Tashkent, 5945, in EG 1110, good. Comment, ID // 6025. (Jones, MS 12-5)+++RM via Blagoveschensk, 9580, in EG 1401-35; Wordl Service nx, NX and Views, fair. // 11840 which was good to VG. (Orcutt, CA 11-27)

VENEZUELA R. Occidente, 3225, in SP 0329; vy good. ID, "Musica Venezuelana." (Jones, MS 11-18) +++ LV de el Tigre, 3255, in SP 0240; fiar. ID, LA pops. (Jones, MISS 12-7)\*\*\*ID on this is now R. 980. tba \*\*LV de Carabobo, 4780, in SP 0346; ID, TC, pop mx. Fair. (Jones, MS 12-1)+++R. Maturin, 5040, in SP 0005+; in sports pgm also on 4770, 4970, 4990, 5030 and 3255 but couldn't tell if //. (Field, MI 12-4)+++R. Sensacion, 5999, in SP 1021; fair. pop mx, ID and bad het. (Jones, MS 11-21) +++R. Turismo, 6178a, in SP 1021; vy good. ID, ads (one for Sherwin-Williams paint), plug for stn itself. (Jones, MS 11-27)
